

Perth Stingrays Ken Fournier Award May 11, 1989 (amended April 2014)

To be eligible for this award, a graduating student must satisfy the following requirements:

1. Have received or be eligible to receive an Ontario Secondary School Diploma within the Perth Stingrays Catchment Area, and
2. Be currently continuing his/her education at the post secondary level, and
3. be, or have been a member of the Perth Stingrays Aquatic Club during each of the two years preceding graduation, or,
 - a. have been a member of the Perth Stingrays Aquatic Club for at least one year of the last two years and have been a member of the PDCI or SJCHS swim teams for at least one year, or
 - b. have been a member of the Perth Stingrays Aquatic Club for a minimum of two years during their high school years
4. Must be selected by the Perth Stingrays Executive using criteria established from time to time by the Executive
5. A swimmer meeting criteria 1 through 3 above must score a minimum of 5 points under the criteria section to be chosen for the award.

Notes:

1. The Perth Stingrays Aquatic Club will advise the Scholarship committees of the name(s) of the recipient(s) by end of April or the appropriate date as set out by the school
2. The criteria under section 3 are hierarchical. Where no student is eligible under 3(a) the criteria under 3(b) shall apply, and so on
3. Where more than one student is deemed equally eligible to receive this award, the award is to be shared by the eligible students
4. The Perth Stingrays Ken Fournier Award shall be a cash award provided to the Scholarship Committee or directly to the student by the PSAC
5. PSAC must confirm that the students meets all the criteria noted above
6. These criteria may be amended from time to time by a majority vote of the Perth Stingrays Executive

Perth Stingrays Ken Fournier Award May 11, 1989 (amended April 2014)

A sub-committee of the Stingray Executive is to recommend a swimmer(s) eligible under Parts 3 and 4 of the award. The sub-committee is to be comprised of the following members: President, Past President (if currently active on the executive), and 1 additional persons chosen from the board of directors.

The committee is to recommend and rank swimmers eligible to receive the Ken Fournier Swimmer Award. Any recommendation of the nominating committee is subject to ratification by the board. At least the two most senior most coaches should be consulted for their recommendation regarding the ranking of swimmers.

The following criteria provide the basis for ranking swimmers:

1. Team Spirit (maximum 8 points)

- a) leadership
- b) regular practice diligence
- c) willingness to assist other team members
- d) involvement in additional team activities

Ranking:

Outstanding----2 points

Good-----1 point

Fair-----0 points

2. Personal Achievement Level (qualification) for minimum competition (maximum 10 points) at any time during their Stingray Career

Ranking:

Local-----0 points

Regional-----2 points

Festival-----4 points

Provincial-----6 points

Canadian Age Group Champs / Eastern Canadian Champs---8 points

Senior National--10 points
