Swimmers who are full time (not seasonal) members of USA Swimming may enter the Speedo Sectionals at Lincoln-2017 through USA Swimming's Online Meet Entry (OME) system at ([usaswimming.org/ome](http://usaswimming.org/ome)) beginning Friday, May 26, 2017 at 1:00 PM CDST. \*Swimmers who are registered members of one of the 5 member LSC's of the Central Section Region VIII have priority entry status for this meet.

**The entry deadline is Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 3:00 PM CDST.** The qualification time date range for this meet begins on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 through Thursday, July 13, 2017. Entries are not accepted until they have been officially submitted in the OME system.

<b>LOCATION</b>	<p>Woods Park Pool, 3200 J St., Lincoln, NE 68510. Located next to the Woods Tennis Center.</p> <p><b>Parking:</b> For a spectator or bus parking map, visit the meet page. <a href="https://www.teamunify.com/SubTabGeneric.jsp?stabid=159692&amp;team=mwlls">https://www.teamunify.com/SubTabGeneric.jsp?stabid=159692&amp;team=mwlls</a> Please <b>DO NOT park on the side streets, your car may be towed.</b></p> <p><b>Facility Access:</b> Access to the facility will be through the bathhouse entrance on the east side or from the west parking lot near the pool pump house. The pool area will be cleared between sessions. Teams and spectators will be allowed to leave tents up overnight throughout the meet. Tent set up will be allowed starting at noon on Tuesday, July 18<sup>th</sup>. A tent will be set up for spectators to get relief from the heat throughout the meet</p> <p><b>Tent Setup Pool Side:</b> No spectator or team tents will be allowed to be set up poolside. Tents will be set up for coaches/athletes to utilize for shade throughout the meet.</p> <p><b>Bleacher Seating:</b> Seating areas for spectators will be set up pool side to view races. A tent shade area will be provided. You can also provide your own tents.</p>
<b>FACILITY</b>	<p>Outdoor 50 meter, 8 lane pool, non-turbulent lane lines, bottom stripes and turn targets, Horn start system, starting platforms on each lane end, Colorado Timing System with read-out board. The water depth of the competition pool measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) from the start wall is 4' 8" – 5'6" and the water depth at the end or turn wall when measured for a distance of 3' 3 1/2" (1 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meters) is 4' 0" – 4' 3". A 25-meter warm-up/down pool adjacent to the competition pool. The diving well will also be used for warm-up/down.</p>

	<b>Pool Certification:</b> Competition pool (50 m) has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Copy of certification is on file with USA Swimming.

<b>TECHNICAL MEETING</b>	A technical meeting of the CSRVIII Chair, Meet Director, Coaches, and Referee is Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at 7:00 PM. Coaches are accountable for ALL information handed out at the Technical Meeting as well as information conducted at the CSRVIII business meeting.
<b>FORMAT</b>	These championships will be conducted in LCM. The 800m and 1500m freestyle and all relays will be timed final events. All other individual events will be conducted as preliminaries and finals with the fastest 32 swimmers from preliminaries advancing to finals. The order of the final events shall be D, C, B and A. <u>The Bonus (D) and (C) Final is reserved for swimmers who are 18 and under.</u> A Ready Room will be used to assemble and parade “A” finalists and the fastest seeded heats of 800m and 1500m freestyle swimmers. These swimmers must report to the Ready Room prior to the start of the D Final for the event.
<b>SEEDING</b>	1. Seeding priority for Summer Meet. a. LCM b. SCY c. LCM Bonus d. SCY Bonus - The lowest seeding <b>priority</b> for this meet is SCY Bonus. 2. All events will be seeded slowest to fastest including the 400 Free and the 400 IM.
<b>DISTANCE EVENTS</b>	Swimmers may qualify for these events using any of the 800m/1000yd or 1500m/1650yd qualifying standards (i.e. the conforming or non-conforming distance event standards). These distance freestyle events will be swum with the fastest heat of each of the women and men in finals in their normal event numbered place. Swimmers in the top 8 <b>MUST USE THEIR CURRENT FASTEST</b> time that they have achieved in the last TWENTY-FIVE (25) months. Swimmers who are not in the top 8 may swim their fastest provable time or down seed to the lowest non-conforming cutoff time prior to the scratch deadline for that day’s events. All bonus swims will be seeded using the lowest non-conforming time for this meet. The slower heats will swim in prelims, after the relays, and will alternate women then men swimming fastest to slowest.  <b>A swimmer who positive checks-in or who does not scratch from an individual event on the last day of the meet and fails to compete is penalized \$50.00 in prelims and \$100.00 in finals.</b>
<b>RELAYS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Relay events will be scored for the top 24 finished regardless of age.</li> <li>• Relays will score double points (64-56-54-52-50-48-46-44-40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2)</li> <li>• There will be no limitations regarding age or how many relay entries a team may have.</li> <li>• Relay entry times at the point of entry into the OME must come from proven times in SWIMS found in the meet qualifying date range. Entry times may be an aggregate of the entered swimmers or a time achieved by the team during the qualifying period. Once the time for the relay is proven through swims no further review of the entry time will happen at the meet.</li> </ul> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The fastest two heats of each women and men will swim in finals. Heats will swim slowest to fastest in finals.</li> <li>2. All remaining heats of relays will swim at the conclusion of that day’s preliminaries and will swim fastest to slowest alternating women then men.</li> <li>3. There is a 10-minute break prior to the start of relays for both prelims and finals.</li> <li>4. <u>ONLY Saturday’s relays may request to swim in the morning or the evening session. Request must be made prior to the scratch deadline (Friday 6:00 PM). All relays will be seeded at their entry time.</u> Open lanes in Saturday’s finals will be permitted.</li> </ol>
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	ATHLETES WHO MAKE A FIRST-TIME CUT AFTER THE CLOSE OF OME MAY ENTER THE MEET. Entry information should be submitted at the venue to the Admin Referee. Do NOT send electronic entry information. Your entries will only be completed at the venue. Bring appropriate proof of qualifying time achievement (Meet mobile is not an acceptable proof of time). Deadline for

entries is the scratch deadline for the event. Proof of time (final results, deck pass, etc.) from a sanction, approved or observed meet is required for entries to be seeded. Only new first-time cuts will be accepted as priority events. Seeding will be the actual time achieved not the conforming time.

If the athlete is already in the meet and the “new time” replaces an already entered “bonus entry”, the new time will replace the bonus seeding. If new bonus entry events are available those will be taken and seeded at the appropriate bonus cuts with proof.

New facility surcharges will apply if the athlete is not already in the meet. If a new athlete allows for the addition of a relay, it will be accepted. Entry fees will be the same as fees for event entered through OME.

1. The meet is open to all full time (not seasonal) swimmers. Athletes must be registered members (either attached or unattached) of USA-Swimming or club and must meet the stated qualifying times.
2. All swimmers must be under the direct supervision of USA Swimming member coach. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race in the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
3. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the athlete is a member as provided in Article 302. On deck registration with USA Swimming will be permitted at this meet. Registration forms and assistance will be available at the Clerk of the Course.
4. Swimmers without a coach present: USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm up, competition and warm down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the swimmer in making arrangements for supervision.
5. Swimmers entering the meet must have at least one provable entry time in order to enter the meet. Bonus swims are offered based on the following:
  - a. 1 proven time allows for 2 bonus events
  - b. 2 proven times allows for 2 bonus events
  - c. 3 proven times allows for 2 bonus events
  - d. 4 proven times allows for 2 bonus events
  - e. 5 proven times allows for 1 bonus events
6. No bonus swims allowed in the 800/1000 or 1500/1650 unless a swimmer has achieved the qualifying time in one of the distance events they may use that to enter the other distance event. All distance bonus swims will be seeded using the lowest non-conforming time for distance events which is SCY (the lowest non-conforming time for all other events is SCY Bonus). Swimmers who want to enter bonus events by using the qualifying time in another distance event must email entries chair at [R8entries@gmail.com](mailto:R8entries@gmail.com), the Meet Referee and the CSRVIII Chair directly as OME will not permit this entry. **This event will be priced at the bonus entry fee rate.**
7. All swimmers MUST be USA Swimming registered athletes in order to be entered into the meet using the OME and in order to receive their credentials. All swimmers must be 2017 athlete members of USA Swimming. The qualifying time date range for the meet begins on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 through Thursday, July 13, 2017. All entries must be submitted using USA Swimming’s Online Meet Entry (OME) procedures. The system can be accessed on the USA Swimming website at [www.usaswimming.org/ome](http://www.usaswimming.org/ome). The OME is available for this meet beginning on Friday, May 26, 2017 at 1:00 PM CDST. Entries will close on Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 3:00 PM CDST. Lincoln Select Swimming will provide a Team Manager Event file on the meet website at [www.lincolnselectswimming.com](http://www.lincolnselectswimming.com) and on the Central Zone Website – [www.centralzones.org](http://www.centralzones.org). This will allow teams to establish the qualifying profile for their swimmers prior to using OME.
8. Entry Fees are payable to the Host, Lincoln Select Swimming. Failure to pay the entry fees will result in the team and/or athletes being scratched from the meet, and they may not compete in the meet until entry fees are paid.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>9. For a swimmer to represent a USA Swimming club in a competitive event, one hundred twenty (120) days must have elapsed without a swimmer having represented any other USA Swimming club in a USA Swimming competition.</li> <li>10. <u>All RELAY ONLY swimmers must be entered into the meet using the OME. Relay only swimmers are restricted to Time Trial entries only unless they have a provable time. Relay Only swimmers must pay the facility surcharge fee in order to be entered in the meet.</u></li> <li>11. Swimmers with a disability who have been classified and have achieved a National Disability Championship Qualifying Time may enter this meet as long as the time is within the qualifying time standards for this meet. Please contact the Meet Director with any questions.</li> </ol>
<b>SWIMS DATABASE</b>	<p>Times from the following will be in SWIMS, the national times database. Times in the database are not automatic entries to meets.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. USA Swimming Sanctioned competition</li> <li>2. USA Swimming Approved competition - Check two weeks before the competition to assure the meet has been approved by the LSC, and prior to the start of the competition, ask the Meet Director for the procedure for getting a time into SWIMS.</li> <li>3. USA Swimming Observed swims - Be sure a proper request for an Observed Swim is made according to guidelines that appear in the USA Swimming SWIMS Time Module Policy Manual, and prior to the start of the meet, verify that proper procedures are in place for the Observed swim.</li> <li>4. The time of any swimmer recorded while legally representing a USA Swimming club, secondary school, college, or university within the appropriate time frame, may be used in proving relay entry times. That swimmer does need to be entered in the championship in question or currently representing that club. Relay times belong to the team. Individual times belong to the swimmer.</li> <li>5. Times submitted to the USA Swimming SWIMS database no later than 20 days prior to the Championships will be in the database. If a time for a swimmer is visible in the public search feature on the USA Swimming website (Times/Time Standards) and it was swum in the appropriate qualifying period, it is considered a proven official time. SWIMS data entry from meets in which time standards were met must be requested from the SWIMS Time Official in the LSC in which the meet was held. These times will not be automatically placed in the database. Relay lead offs and/or intermediate split times must be requested from the SWIMS Time official in the LSC where the time was achieved.</li> <li>6. Times that occur at a qualifying event the weekend prior to the closing of the OME that are not in SWIMS will be accepted with appropriate proof at the venue beginning Tuesday, July 18, 2017. Proof must be provided by the scratch deadline.</li> </ol>
<b>ENTRIES</b>	<p>All entries must be made online using OME. OME is not an eligibility report. It is the coach's responsibility to know for which events his or her athlete is qualified. Only times found in the SWIMS database are used for seeding in this meet. All entry times must have been achieved between the qualifying time date range for the meet beginning on Wednesday, June 17, 2015 through Thursday, July 13, 2017. Each entry time used must be from a "Sanctioned" or "Approved" meet, or from an "Observed Swim" in accordance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. <b>The OME for this event is formatted to force the use the fastest provable entry time found during the qualifying entry period.</b></p> <p>The host will provide a Team Manager or suitable event file on the host web site and at the time of the distribution of the Meet Book to the club contacts. The event file can be used to assist you in completing your entries in the OME.</p> <p>Coaches can update entry times until the close of the OME. By not checking-out, coaches maintain the flexibility to remove swimmers or events. Once you check out of the OME you cannot delete existing entries. You may return to update times for existing athletes, add new swimmers and events up until the close of the OME entry period. You must check out of the OME prior to the entry deadline to have your entries placed in the meet. Times entered in the OME do not automatically update. If there have been improved times since you started the entry process the coach or person making entries must update times for this process to happen. If you do not receive a confirmation from the OME you need to contact us immediately. After an entry has been submitted, removals</p>

	<p>must be managed by the Meet Admin Staff. Once you have completed your online entry, you will receive an email confirmation. Please keep ALL electronic correspondence and bring them with you to the meet.</p> <p>Coaches MUST use OME to apply for credentials. Please see credential area for more information.</p> <p><b>Entry limits:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Each swimmer may enter as many events as they qualify for, but may compete in only a maximum of 6 individual events plus relays for the total meet.</li> <li>2. Each swimmer may compete in no more than 3 individual events per day including Time Trials.</li> <li>3. Time Trials <u>DO NOT</u> count towards the total number of events allowed for the meet.</li> </ol> <p><b>Entry deadline:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. All entries must be submitted using OME (see OME entry procedures) by Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 3:00 PM CDST.</li> <li>5. Psych Sheets are electronically sent to the person on file for the club entry based on contacts from the OME. Psych Sheets are made available to each attending team and posted on the club web site: <a href="http://www.lincolnselectswimming.com">www.lincolnselectswimming.com</a> by no later than Saturday, July 15, 2017 at 6:00 PM CDST. Following the distribution of the psych sheet additional changes will only be accepted at the meet during registration or before the scratch deadline for that day's events.</li> </ol> <p><b>Swimmers with Disabilities:</b> Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require accommodations, including the need for any personal assistance and/or registered service animals, must provide advance notice in writing, accompanying their meet entry file, to the meet director by the entry deadline. Entries are accepted only for swimmers already entered in the meet.</li> <li>2. Entries are accepted on the deck up until the check-in/scratch deadline time for that day's events.</li> <li>3. All individual deck entries are seeded at the lowest non-conforming qualifying time for this meet which is SCY bonus.</li> <li>4. All relay deck entries, are seeded at the lowest non-conforming qualifying time for this meet which is SCY.</li> </ol> <p>NOTE: See eligibility section for deck entry rules for athletes who have received a first time cut.</p>

	<p><b>Below is the process for clubs of individuals who have failed to complete entries prior to the entry deadline.</b> All entries both individual (attached or unattached) swimmers and club entries that were missed at the entry deadline for this meet must complete the following steps in order to enter the meet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All swimmers must have at least one provable cut to enter the meet.</li> <li>2. All entry fines go to CSRVIII Travel Fund.</li> <li>3. <b>Fees for entries not <u>submitted</u> through the OME by the Entry Deadline</b> Thursday, July 13, 2017 at 3:00 PM CDST:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Facility Surcharge \$21.00. \$20.00 goes to host and \$1.00 goes to Central Zone.</li> <li>b. Individual Event Deck Entry Fee is \$20.00. \$12.00 goes to host and \$8.00 goes to CSRVIII Travel Fund.</li> <li>c. Relay Entry Fee is \$40.00. \$24.00 goes to the host and \$16.00 goes to the CSRVIII Travel Fund.</li> <li>d. <b>Fine for failure to enter by the close of the OME</b> is <u>\$50.00 per swimmer</u> (with a maximum fine of \$300.00 for a club) who did not submit their entries through the official entry platform before the entry deadline.</li> <li>e. <p><b>CREDENTIALS</b></p>	<p>This meet is a closed deck. All swimmers, coaches, officials and meet volunteers must display their meet credentials to be on deck. Additionally, all coaches, chaperones and team managers should participate in the OME Deck Pass process.</p> <p><b>Coaches Credentials:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All coaches in attendance must wear meet credentials and their current USA Swimming registration cards while on deck.</li> <li>2. Coaches must participate in the Deck Pass request in the OME process. This will allow us to verify in advance the certifications of all coaches who are in attendance. The host will notify coaches whose recon shows any compliance items requiring attention prior to arrival at the venue.</li> <li>3. Those coaches who do not participate in the Deck Pass process during the OME entry period must provide all necessary certification documentation at the "registration/check in" area prior to receiving any meet credentials, coach packets, swimmer "goody bag items" and athlete meet credentials.</li> <li>4. <b>DISTANCE/ RELAY CHECK-IN</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All distance events swimmers (800/1500) and relays MUST positively check-in by the scratch deadline for that day's events TO BE SEEDED.</li> <li>Positive check-in deadline for Wednesday's events is 15 minutes after the completion of the CSRVIII business meeting. Meeting to be held Tuesday, July 18, 2017 at 7:00 PM CDST. Positive check-in deadline for Thursday, Friday, and Saturday's events is 30 minutes after the beginning of the previous day's finals.</li> <li>If coaches do not arrive on Tuesday prior to the positive check-in deadlines, they must make prior arrangements with the Meet Referee if they want their distance swimmer or relay seeded.</li> <li>Declaration of swimmer names and order of swims is required 1 hour prior to swimming the relays.</li> </ol>
