- Time:** Warm-up: 10:00 a.m. – 10:45 p.m. Meet Start: 11:00 a.m.
- Location:** **CLOVIS OLYMPIC SWIM COMPLEX**
Clovis West High School. 1070 E. Teague Fresno, CA 93720. From the south: highway 99 (N) to 41 (N) to Herndon Avenue, east on Herndon to Millbrook, north on Millbrook to the corner of Millbrook & Teague. Continue on Millbrook to Cole and turn right and then immediately right into the campus parking lot. From the north: take highway 99 (S) to Herndon Avenue, east on Herndon and follow the directions above.
- Facility:** 50 M x 25 yard competition pool. The main competition pool is all deep at 7 feet. The adjacent 25 meter diving will provide an additional 6 for continuous warm up and warm down. The competition course has been certified according to articles 104.2.2 C (4) of USAS rules and regulations.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. For Athlete Protection, Central California Swimming prohibits the use of photography and audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, behind the starting blocks during the start sequence throughout the meet. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Deck changes are prohibited. Propane heaters are prohibited. NO RV Overnight Parking is allowed by Clovis Unified School District.
- Format:** This is a timed finals short course yards Senior meet.
- Warm-up:** All USAS athlete members must be under the supervision of a USAS registered coach during warm-up. Dive and pace lanes will be assigned at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Warm-up procedures will be posted on deck and announced on a continuous basis by the Meet and/or Deck Referee. **Swimmers must use “3-point” entries when entering the water for warm-up and warm-down.**
- Rules:** Current USAS and CCS rules will apply. All swimmers must be 2019 USAS registered. Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming Membership. Verification of entered times should be available upon request of the Meet Referee. This meet will be **PRE-SEEDED**. Events will be seeded in heats running **SLOWEST TO FASTEST** according to submitted times. This is a timed finals swim meet. **Swimmers may compete in up to 3 individual events and 2 relays.** Swimmers in 500 yard or longer events shall supply their own timer and lap counter. Lap counting devices will be provided. Proof that all coach and official membership requirements are met, as of the date of competition, shall be presented upon request by the Meet Referee. Proof may be in the form of a coach or official membership card or through Deck Pass. All USAS athlete members must be under the supervision of a USAS member coach during warm up, competition and warm-down. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water.
- Entry Fees:** \$15/athlete. ***Please make all checks payable to “Clovis Swim Club.” No Refunds.***
- Entries:** All entries must be submitted electronically using an electronic entry file compatible with Hy-Tek Meet Manager software To submit Hy-Tek Team Manager entries send the entry file and meet entry report as attachments to johnmcgough@cusd.com.



Entry Deadline: All Entries must be received by **Wednesday, October 16, 2019, @ 11:59 pm.**

Eligibility: All swimmers currently registered with USA Swimming and members (attached or unattached) of CLOV, PASA, and SMST. All entrants' membership will be verified through the USA Swimming database. **On-deck USAS membership registration will be allowed with a \$20 fee payable by the home club.**

As the number of certified officials allows, interested parents/trainees are also welcome to shadow working officials for education and/or mentoring.
