## ENTRIES

Entry Fees: Individual  
Heats Finals events \$12.00/event  
Timed Final events \$10.00/event  
Relays \$15.00

Entry Fees are non-refundable after the scratch deadline

Entry Deadline: **Friday May 20, 2022 11:59PM**, an early entry deadline date is to allow meet management to determine session timeouts and evaluate if additional entries can be accommodated if the meet is oversubscribed

Deck Entries: Deck Entries will be charged \$20.00/ event for all individual events, Relays \$25.00. All Deck Entries are exhibition swims, and will not be scored.

Refunds: No refunds for any scratched swimmers after Entry Deadline

Expected Entries:

- Maximum of 400 Swimmers and Minimum 200 swimmers. The meet will accept up to 400 swimmers. This will be dependent on a reasonable time out for the morning sessions that does not exceed available pool time. Entries will be first come first serve. Please submit entries early. Nose Creek Swim Association has reserved 150 swimmers.

Entry Procedures:

- All entries to be submitted using Hy-tek through the Swimming Canada online system.
- All entries must contain the **swimmer's name, Swimming Canada swimmer ID and date of birth**. If entering from outside of Canada, please email Hy-tek file directly to the entries email
- Please enter all events with a time. **NT's will not be accepted.**
- Swimmers are limited to a maximum of seven events
- A maximum of two events per session, with the exception of Session 1. Swimmers can only enter either the 800m or 1500m.
- Clubs may be limited to the number of relay teams per relay event or the event canceled based on session timeout
- Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system
- Deck Entries will be "Exhibition" only and accepted only if the entry does not create a new heat. They must be submitted no later than the Late Scratch Deadline of that session.
- **Swimmers who have achieved the Alberta Champion time in a given event for their age level (short course and/or long course), may swim Preliminaries as Exhibition, but are not eligible for Finals.**

Official Split Time:

- Official Split time request deadline is 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the official split is requested. The coaches are required to complete an "Official Split Request Form".
- There will be a fee of \$5.00 for each single official split request. The fee is payable to the Clerk of Course at the time of the request.

Age Groups:

Individual events

50m,100m, 200m, 400m distance events. Finals to be swum in the following age groups:

- Girls: 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15&over,
- Boys: 11&under, 12-13, 14-15, 16&over

800m and 1500m Free

- Mixed Gender: Open Age

Relay events

- Girls: 12&under, 13&over
- Boys: 12&under, 13&over

## MEET INFORMATION

### Rules:

- The meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or WPS rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- Swimming Canada warm-up procedures will be in effect.

### Safe Sport:

- All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both “open” and “observable” to others.

### COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

- All participants, including swimmers, coaches, officials & volunteers, will be required to adhere to AHS/Swim Alberta/City of Calgary/Repsol restrictions & requirements pertaining to COVID-19. These may include, but not be limited to, proof of vaccination and wearing a mask while within the facility. These restrictions/requirements are subject to change and will be communicated closer to the event date.

### Competition and Diving Readiness Standards

- Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.

### Diving Rules:

- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW 4.1.

### Meet Format – Timed Final and Preliminary Events

- 50, 100, and 200 events will be swum slowest to fastest
- 400, 800, 1500 free, and 400 IM will be seeded fastest to slowest and will be timed final events.
- 1500 free - entries limited to top 24 mixed gender swimmers.
- 800 free - entries limited to top 40 mixed gender swimmers.
- 400 freestyle – entries limited to top 32 each gender swimmers.
- 400IM – entries limited to top 16 each gender swimmers.
- Swimmers not making the entry limit can swim the 400 free, 800 free, 1500 free and 400 IM at their home pool as a time trial with time submitted to the Clerk of Course upon arrival at the meet.
- All relay events are timed finals

**\*\*\*Event order to be confirmed after deadline date to make session length reasonable\*\*\***

### Meet Format – Finals Sessions

- “A” finals only for Girls 10&under and Boys 11&under - 50m and 100m stroke events
- “A” & “B” finals for Girls 11-12, 13-14, and 15&over / Boys 12-13, 14-15 and 16&over - 50m and 100m, stroke events. B” Finals - will only be run if 16 swimmers entered in event (not including exhibition swimmers)

- “A” final only for Girls 11-12, 13-14 and 15&over / Boys 12-13, 14-15 and 16&over - 200 Free and 200 IM.

Relays:

- Provide swimmers name and name changes to the Clerk of Course 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Clubs may be limited to the number of relay teams per relay event based on session timeout

Scratches:

- **The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition.**
- Scratches are to be submitted to the NCSA Meet Manager before 3:00 pm the day prior to the start of the session, in order that the session can be seeded.
- To make the meet run more efficiently any last minute scratches would be appreciated until **Thursday, June 23, 2022 by 3:00PM**. Please notify us by email, [entries@ncsaswim.ca](mailto:entries@ncsaswim.ca).
- Late scratches for timed final events and preliminaries: Submit to the Clerk of Course 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. No re-seeding will occur. Meet Management may collapse heats within an event to optimize meet proceedings.

Scratch Deadline and Penalties for Finals:

- Scratches are to be submitted to the clerk of course 30 minutes after conclusion of the preliminary session. The conclusion of the preliminary session will be the completion of the final race of the session.
- The Late Scratch Deadline shall be 30 minutes prior to the start of the finals session. However, there shall be no re-seeding to include scratches made after the initial scratch deadline.
- Scratches received after the late scratch deadline, no-shows, step-downs and unexcused incomplete swims will result in the swimmer(s) being scratched from all remaining events, including relays, scheduled for that day.

Awards:

- Awards will be given in the following age groups:
  - Girls: 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15&over
  - Boys: 11&under, 12-13, 14-15, 16&over
- Medals for top 3 places
- Ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> places for Girls: 10&under, 11-12 and Boys: 11&under, 12-13 in 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m individual events.

- Medals for top 3 places in 800FR, 1500FR open age, mixed gender
- Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> place and ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in relay events

Heat Winners Awards:

- Draws for prizes for swimmers winning their heat will be drawn during session 2,4 and 6. Winners will be announced during the swim meet.
- All prizes must be collected by swimmers or their coach(es) at the conclusion of the Competition.
