

Aspen Swim Club Officials Policy (Adopted 4/17/19)

Aspen Swim Club operates with the help of parent volunteers to help serve on the board, to fundraise, and to help run meets. Becoming an official with USA Swimming is one of the volunteer opportunities that is vital to our club to be sustainable and to help other swim clubs in the Western Slope League and across the state. Becoming an official requires a time commitment for training and for working that is much greater than other volunteer responsibilities. With this in mind the club is willing to offer some financial incentive to Aspen Swim Club parents to become officials in return for the service they provide the club.

Aspen Swim Club will reimburse parents for their children's session dues, at the conclusion of each session, after the following requirements have been met:

- 1) The parent must complete an officials clinic, and on deck training hours and be certified as a USA swimming official. They must remain in good standing and continue to progress in levels as an official.*
- 2) The parent must work any Aspen Swim Club home meets during the session. (They must work all sessions of the Aspen Meet.)*
- 3) The parent must work any WSL Championship meets during the session. (They must work at least two sessions of the meet) (Steps 1-3 will count for 75% off of dues)*
- 4) If the parent works an additional 2 meets (at least two sessions per meet) then he/she can receive an additional 25% off of dues.*
