

Protocols for APS Pool Rentals

If any participant (coach, volunteer, swimmer, etc...) is discovered to be COVID-19 positive, after attending a practice, you are required to notify APS Security immediately by calling 303-367-3060.

General Guidance for Pool Rentals

Limit the maximum number of participants to 25% of the fire code capacity of the pool (including staff) OR 50 participants (including staff), whichever is fewer.

Full names of all participants with current contact information must be recorded at each session.

Provide communication in advance to swimmers, parents and coaches regarding what to expect during practice.

Provide training materials to coaches on how to maintain social distancing, traffic flow patterns in exit/entrance areas, and to answer questions.

Swimmers and coaches will arrive and depart in swimsuits. Locker rooms are unavailable for changing or showering.

Bleachers/stands are closed. Spectators are prohibited at this time.

Hallway restrooms may be used, one person at a time.

Parents and swimmers are prohibited from gathering in the lobby, parking lot or other common areas before, during and after practice.

There will be a 30 minute break between sessions to minimize contact between groups.

Entrance and exit doors must be managed by designated individuals to limit touch-points.

Follow all social/physical distancing requirements. Swimmers should maintain 6' distance in the water and on the pool deck.

Each swimmer and coach must be at least 6 feet apart at all times during strenuous land workouts. Swimmers may remove masks during workouts.

Coaches or volunteers will monitor and provide controls to ensure social distancing is practiced at time of arrival and dismissal.

Shared equipment is required to be frequently cleaned and changed out during sessions.

Sharing personal protective equipment or other personal items is prohibited.

No distribution of food or beverages will occur.

Maximize ventilation by using fans and propping open doors whenever possible.

Assessment of Attendees

Temperature Scans are required for each participant, prior to entering the building.

Vinyl gloves are to be worn by the person conducting wellness checks.

The purchase of a temperature scanning device is the responsibility of the rental customer.

A coach or volunteer will take each swimmer's temperature and ask about signs of illness before entering the pool or building. Disallow individuals with elevated temperatures or signs of illness.

Sanitization Practices

Hand sanitizer must be provided and placed in convenient locations.

APS custodial staff will disinfect basic surfaces (restrooms, doors, tables, etc...) prior to and after practice.

The rental customer is responsible for disinfecting surfaces and doors (while wearing vinyl gloves) during practice or anytime an area is vacated or a group rotates.

Face Coverings/Masks

Masks are required to be worn by swimmers, except while in the water or during strenuous land work outs. Coaches are required to wear masks at all times except in the water.

Coaches are considered employees for the purposes of Safer-At Home requirements. As such, they must be wearing a mask if they will have contact with other employees, parents or swimmers.

All participants are required to wear face coverings over their mouths and noses while attending team meetings on APS property.
