

FST Banquet Awards Eligibility

Each spring we celebrate the previous years accomplishment. The previous year is defined through the dates of (April 01 - March 31). The following levels of achievement are awarded:

14 Under State

Senior State

All Stars

Age Group Western Zones

Sectionals

Futures

Junior Nationals

Eligibility and Recognition

- Swimmers are awarded at their highest level of achievement.
- To become eligible for recognition of achievement swimmers only need to qualify for the level of achievement. They do not have to attend the meet.
- Swimmers will be awarded for achievement of a standard even if they age up.
- The age at the time of the achievement will determine the achievement
- Achievement isn't based on eligibility for said meet, just the time standards
- All stars: only awarded during SC season because it is a SC season meet

Age Up Example: Swimmer "A" makes the 11-12 age group qualifying standard for 14 and Under State Meet. They make this standard halfway through the Short Course season. Swimmer "A" then ages up to 13 prior to the 14 and Under State Meet. Although they are no longer eligible to participate in the state meet as a 12 year old, FST will still award them for achieving the standard that they achieved prior to aging up.
