Old Business:

- A. - A. Rule changes:
Proposed by Lynn Williams, Rock Hill
All swimmers entering any event 200 yards or longer in the Championship meet must have a proveable entry time. NT entries will not be accepted for any event 200 yards or longer.

After much discussion about the rule change and the order of events being in line with the events offered at the Winter championship a committee of Jeff Meade, YCSC, Tim Conley, RAYS and Larry McMahan, PCY was established to look into the

order of events. A motion was made by Lynn Williams, seconded by Robert Thornal. Motion passed.
