- 14 5. Provide an Alternative Solution
- 15 6. Mark as Not Within Technical Committee Jurisdiction

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Location: Championship Administrative Guide – **Seeding Procedure**

Purpose: Placing the exhibition tag on swimmers entered late (usually due to a coach's error) unduly punishes the swimmer, makes extra work for the host and doesn't lead to the most competitive swimming.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

Eliminate Exhibition Tag from Late entry penalty. The following section of the entry letter will be deleted:

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Location: Championship Administrative Guide – **Charges**

Purpose: Insure that attending the state meets (Divisional, Age Group, & Senior) are not an undue financial burden on athletes and their families by creating a LSC mandated maximum level.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

The following fee structure will be incorporated into all Indiana LSC state meets. The contracted host clubs can continue to set their own pricing based on the facility utilized but it may no exceed the schedule below. All clubs are encouraged to be as financially friendly as possible to those people attending the championship meets:

- **Preliminary Session – Max \$4**
- **Timed Finals – Max \$1**
- **Finals – Max \$1**

Purpose: Increase the number of opportunities for our Age Group athletes to participate at the championship level.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

Increase the maximum number of events at Age Group State and Divisionals from 5 to 6. The entry letter will be changed as follows:

ENTRY LIMITS

- Swimmers may enter an unlimited number of events.
- Must scratch down to ~~5~~ 6 events for the entire meet plus relays.
- No more than three (3) individual events per day (this includes time trials) are allowed.

Reinstate Positive Check-in for both Distance and Relay events at Senior State. The following verbiage will be added to the SCY and LCM Senior State entry letter:

Entrants in the 1500/1650 freestyle and all relays must check in and confirm their intention to compete before the scratch deadline in order to be seeded.

Location: Championship Administrative Guide – **Senior State Championship Format**

Purpose: Increase number of Individual Entries to 9 in order to encourage participation in newly added 50's and the National Championships have no Individual Entry limit.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

Increase the maximum number of events at Senior State from 6 to 9. The entry letter will be changed as follows:

ENTRY LIMITS

- Swimmers may enter an unlimited number of events.
- Must scratch down to ~~6~~ 9 events for the entire meet plus relays.
- No more than three (3) individual events per day (this includes time trials) are allowed.

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Location: Championship Administrative Guide – **Open Water Championship Format**

Purpose: To provide the best possible competition and safest conditions when there is a large number of athletes by creating multiple heats.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

When there are a large # of athletes entered (80+ per age group), create multiple heats in specific age groups (12 & Under) for safety. The need for such heats will be determined by the Meet Referee based on the number of entered athletes and the layout of the championship course. If this determination is made at the meet referee's discretion than these procedures must be communicated to teams prior to the competition. These heats should be seeded by using entry times to provide the best opportunity for competition.

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Location: Championship Administrative Guide – **Open Water Championship Proof of Time**

Purpose: Pre-prove entry times for Open Water State like we do for all the other LSC Championship meets. This will also make it possible to seed multiple heats should that legislation be adopted.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

Indiana Swimming will provide meet host with pre-proven list of all eligible swimmers based on the longest distance event per age group.

Purpose: To alleviate sprint lane congestion.

Recommendation: *The Technical Committee recommends **Adoption** of this Item.*

Add 2 more sprint lanes from 7:30-9:45 am. Also add 1 more sprint lane to the 10 & U warm-up.

Statement of the purpose of the legislation:

“Indiana Swimming creates opportunities for swimmers to realize their dreams. We believe these dreams should be realized through a developmental progression based on an athlete’s commitment, skills and willingness to sacrifice to achieve excellence, rather than on a piece of equipment designed specifically to provide a short cut to success.

What we are really defending is the psychological development of the child athlete. Is the lesson they learn, “I can buy improvement” or is it “I have to earn improvement”.

Additionally, the rule to limit certain swimsuits for 12 and under age group swimmers is important to the objective of continuing to make swimming a sport and fitness activity of relatively low entry cost for the youngest of its competitors.”

102.9 Swimwear - Page 28

.1 Design

- A. Swim suits worn by 12 and under males participating in all Indiana Swimming sanctioned “age group” competitions will not extend above the navel or below the knees.
- B. Swim suits worn by 12 and under females participating in all Indiana Swimming sanctioned “age group” competitions will not cover the neck, extend past the shoulders; extend beyond the shoulder, nor below the pelvis.
- C. Swimsuits worn for competition must be non-transparent and conform to the current concept of appropriate.
- D. The referee shall have the authority to bar offenders from the competition until they comply with the rule.

Informational Note: Additional language to clarify that 12 & under swimmers participating in senior events are not subject to this provision is not needed because of the following articles:

Rule 205.4: AGE GROUP ELIGIBILITY - A swimmer must compete in the age group events corresponding to the swimmer’s age except when competing in consolidating events, mixed classification events and in events combined by the referee.

Rule 204.2: SENIOR ELIGIBILITY – All registered swimmers are eligible to compete in the Senior Class.

The rule would have an effective date of October 6, 2008
