This policy is on an ongoing basis until the State of Minnesota provides a change in aspect from our current “phase 3” designation to “phase 4”. MNSI will be limited to the sanctioning of meets comprised only of athletes and clubs registered within the LSC.\*

(\*A club, geographically isolated within MNSI, may be granted the opportunity to compete in an adjacent LSC with permission from both the club’s LSC and the adjacent LSC.)

MNSI cannot limit MNSI members, including both teams and individuals, from traveling to other LSC's, but it strongly recommends any club or individual traveling outside of LSC borders familiarize themselves with all local and state recommendations, orders and health codes for both the LSC they are traveling to and the Minnesota or Wisconsin Department of Health guidelines upon return, including recommended quarantine periods.

An ad-hoc committee will meet each month and provide guidance for the month immediately following chronologically.

The committee will be comprised of the following BOD Chair positions and staff members: Operational Risk Chair, Administrative Vice Chair, Age Group Chair, Executive Director and Sport Development Director. Staff will post information for the following month by the 15th thru the 17th of the previous month (example - by September 16th for the month of November). The ad-hoc committee would also determine if a team met the criteria of being "geographically isolated" to host a competition with a team from an adjacent LSC. For the months of September and October 2020 teams outside of MNSI will not be allowed to participate in MNSI sanctioned meets.
