WARM-UPS The first 30 minutes will be circle swim. No diving into the

pool. Enter pool feet first. Lane 1 is reserved for 8 and under. For the second half hour, lanes 2, 3, 4, and 5 will be for sprints with diving allowed. Swimmers must exit from the shallow end. Lane 6 will continue as circle swim. Officials will be on deck during warm-ups with authority to disqualify swimmers not

following warm-up procedures.

TIMING SYSTEM: Colorado electronic timing system with strobe/horn start, touch

pads and manual back-up timing buttons. Each lane will have two timers with electronic stop watches. All events will be

timed finals.

ENTRY LIMIT: Each Swimmer is allowed to enter 4 individual events and 2

relays. Meet is limited to the first 1200 entries. Reservations must be accompanied by checks for the number of swims to be

reserved. No refunds will be given.
