Facility: Indoor, six lane, 25 meter pool. Pool depth is 9-12 feet at the start end and 3' 6" at the turn end.

Starting blocks are 30" high. Ample parking and spectator seating is available. Concessions will be available. No food or beverage is allowed in the pool area. The competition course has not been

certified in accordance with USA Swimming's Rule 104.2.2C(4).

Timing: All events will be timed finals. Colorado timing system with touch pads and horn start, as well as

button and manual timing backup with two timers per lane.

Rules: Current USA Swimming 2017 and Wisconsin Swimming rules shall govern the conduct of this meet.

All athletes must be registered USA Swimming members. Age is as of November 18, 2017. Out of state entrants must bring valid USA Swimming card and present it to the Meet Director prior to swimming. All coaches, acting in a coaching capacity, must display the current membership card at

all times while on deck.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal

guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Warm-up Guidelines:

First 30 minutes – All lanes circle swim

Last 30 minutes – One-way sprint and/or pace lanes will be designated by the Meet

Director as needed.

Feet first, three-point entries from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced at all times. Failure to follow warm-up guidelines may result in disqualification from the

next individual event.

Entries & Eligibility:

<u>Completed entry forms, signed waiver and fees must be received no later than Tuesday, October</u>

<u>31st</u>, <u>2017</u>. This is a pre-seeded meet and all entry times must be in meters. Any questions concerning

Swimmers are limited to four (4) individual events per day & two (2) relays per day. Entries will be accepted in the order they are received.

Deck seeding will only be allowed if there are open lanes available up until 30 minutes prior to each session's warm-ups. All deck entries are \$10.00 per event, plus entry fees. Decision to grant deck seeding is up to the Meet Director. All swimmers must be registered USA swimmers and their USA Swimming number MUST be listed on the official entry form, this includes relay-only swimmers. Deck registrations will not be accepted.

Medical: Please indicate on the entry forms any special needs your swimmers may have that require assistance.

Also, please inform the head official of those needs prior to the start of the meet.

Entry Fees: \$4.50 per individual event

\$12.00 per relay event \$3.00 Splash Fee

Entry fees must accompany the official entry form and are non-refundable. Please make checks

payable to "MSS".

Events: All events will be pre-seeded, except as indicated below for positive check-in events.

All events 400 meters and longer will be positive check-in events, and may be limited to the top 18

swimmers.

Positive check-in for these events will be made at the meet management table, ending 30 minutes prior

to the beginning of the session in which the event is swum.

Fly-over starts will be used during this meet.

100 Relay Events: For the 2nd and 4th legs of all 100 meter relay events, swimmers will start in the water.

Admission: \$5.00 admission fee per session for spectators over the age of 12.

Heat sheets are an additional \$5.00.

Awards: Individual Events – 1st - 12th place ribbons

Relay Events – 1st – 3rd place ribbons

Heat winner awards will be given for all events.

Final Results: An electronic copy of all meet results will be sent to participating teams.

Conduct: Each team is responsible for the behavior of their swimmers.

It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the blocks at the start of his/her event.

Spectators are to be seated in the bleachers or may stand in the open viewing area at the shallow end of the pool, opposite the starting blocks. Swimmers and swimmer's bags are not allowed in the bleachers. No flash photography allowed during the starts.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

The Meet Director and/or Meet Marshall may remove any swimmer from competition for disruptive ordisorderly behavior.

In accordance with the Federal Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004—the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.
