Location	Sun Prairie High School, 888 Grove Street, Sun Prairie WI 53590						
Facility	Indoor 25 yard pool with eight 7' lanes, non-turbulent lane markers, backstroke flags, 32" Paragon quick start slanted starting blocks, guttered pool. Pool depth is 12' at the starting block end and 3 1/2' at the opposite end. Either 6 lanes (with lane 7 closed, lane 8 for warmup/cooldown) or 8 lanes will be used for competition, as determined by the meet directors based on the number of entries. <b>The Competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C).</b>						
Timing	All events (with the exception of 25-yard races) will be timed using Colorado System 6 timing system with Strobe/Horn Start, Touch pads, one button, and 2 watches as backup. All 25-yard races will be timed with buttons/watches.

Entry Deadline	With the change from "reservation" to "non-reservation" status, the meet will allow entries in the following fashion: *Clubs that were entered for the 2016 Winter Classic may send in entries as early as November 1 <sup>st</sup> . *New Wisconsin Swimming clubs may send in entries as early as November 8 <sup>th</sup> . *New out-of-LSC clubs may send in entries as early as November 15 <sup>th</sup> . Entries will be accepted in a first-come, first-served fashion. If/when the meet fills, all further entries will be denied. The window for new entries will close Monday, December 4 <sup>th</sup> , 2017 Entry times may be updated through Monday, December 11 <sup>th</sup> , 2017

Entry Times	<b>NT entries will not be accepted.</b> Entry times may be USA Sanctioned times, high school, rec league, practice time trials, etc, but must be yard times.						
Deck Entries	Deck entries must be able to prove their USA Swimming membership. There are no additional fees for deck-entered swimmers after the initial meet entry fees.

Official Rules	2017 USA and Wisconsin Swimming Rules shall govern this meet. <b>All swimmers must hold current USA Swimming registration.</b>						
Racing Start Certification	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement						

Warm-Ups	Warmup schedule will be posted by meet director and sent to teams.
Age Groups	Friday's events will be grouped together for seeding, but split apart into age groups for scoring. Saturday's events will have age groups blended together for prelims, but separate for finals. Age groups are: 6-under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-Over
Seeding	It is the swimmer's responsibility to be at the blocks at the start of his/her event. Deck seeding will only be used to fill heats already created.  Events will be competed fast-to-slow.  Friday's events & Sunday's 11-over 500FR will be seeded mixed but separated for scoring.  Deck seeding will close 30 minutes prior to the start of competition.
Pos Check-In	All of Friday's events and Sunday's 500 freestyle will be positive check-in. Positive check-in for Friday's events will close at 4:30PM. Positive check-in for Sunday's 500 will close at the start of the 500FR warmup.
Staging	Staging may be used in the hallway adjacent to the pool for Saturday/Sunday events, based on the number of entries for the session.
Fly-Over Starts	Fly-over starts will be used.
Qualifying for Finals	A "superfinal" of the top 6 qualifiers, regardless of age, will be swum in finals. The number of additional finals heats will be determined by the number of entries in the preliminary swims. 20 or less entries in prelims....."A Final" of 6 swimmers 21-36 entries...."A Final" of 6 swimmers and "B Final" of 6 swimmers 37+ entries...."A Final" of 6 swimmers, "B Final" of 6 swimmers, and "C Final of 6 swimmers" The number of heats for each finals event will be sent to coaches after the entry window closes and will be listed in the preliminary heat sheet.
Scratch Policy	<b><u>Prelims &amp; Timed Finals</u></b> Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event shall not be penalized. Any swimmer not reporting for or competing in a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized. <b><u>Positive Check-in Events</u></b> Any swimmer entered in an individual event who has checked-in for the event, must swim in the event. Failure to swim the event will result in the swimmer being barred from his/her individual event in which the swimmer is entered on that day or the next day, whichever is first. No penalty shall apply for a failure to compete if the swimmer or the coach notifies the Deck Referee, prior to his/her assigned heat, of a Declared False Start. <b><u>Failure to Show in Finals</u></b> Any swimmer qualifying for a bonus heat, consolation final, or final race in an individual event, who fails to compete in said bonus, consolation final, or final race, shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. Disqualification under this section shall apply only to swimmers qualifying based on the original preliminary results. However, if a swimmer or coach is notified prior to the start of the session, that the swimmer has scratched into a bonus heat, consolation final, or final race in an individual event, and that accepts the position, and then fails to compete, that swimmer shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the Meet Referee shall fill the bonus, consolation final, or final race, when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if not available to compete in finals. However, if an alternate is notified that he/she has scratched into a bonus heat, consolation final, or final race prior to the start of the session, and that swimmer accepts the position, and then does not compete, that swimmer is barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. When bonus/consolation finals have not been swim and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Meet Referee, the Meet Referee shall reseed the bonus/consolation final, and final, if necessary, by inserting the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final race. If a bonus heat or consolation final has been contested, the remaining final shall be swum without reseeding for empty lane(s). Finals shall include those events in a preliminary-finals competition but swum as timed finals, with the

	<p>fastest heat swimming in finals. A swimmer who fails to compete in a timed final event or in the fastest heat swimming with finals, who has checked-in for the positive check-in, is barred from competing in the next individual event in which the swimmer is entered either on that day or the next day, whichever is first. A Declared False Start is allowed in a timed final event with the fastest heat swimming with finals.</p> <p><b>Exceptions for failure to compete</b> – No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or to compete in an individual check-in event if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Meet Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.</li> <li>• A swimmer qualifying for A, B, or C (bonus heat or consolation final or final race) race, based upon the results of the preliminaries, notifies the Meet Referee within thirty (30) minutes after announcement of the qualifiers for that race that he/she may not intend to compete, and further declares his/her intention not to compete within thirty (30) minutes following his/her last individual preliminary event of the session.</li> <li>• The Meet Referee determines that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.</li> </ul>
Awards	Ribbons will be given for places 1-6. High point awards will be given to 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place in each age group.

Heat Sheets	No heat sheet Friday or for Sunday 500s; all others will be sold together for \$5.00; finals heat sheets on Saturday will be free.
Concessions	Concessions and hospitality will be provided
Meet Conduct	<p>In accordance with USA Swimming rules, NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.</p> <p>Deck changing is prohibited.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p>
