Approved Meet: A Meet conducted by a USA Swimming member club or a non USA Swimming member organization in accordance with USA Swimming technical rules in which both USA Swimming athlete members and non USA Swimming athletes participate.

APPROVAL: a permit issued by an LSC for meets conducted in conformance with USA Swimming technical rules in which both members and non-members may compete.

ATTACHED: An athlete member who represents a USA Swimming member club in competition after having met the requirements of USA Swimming Article 303. status of an athlete member who represents a member club in competition after having met the requirements of USA Swimming Article 203.

CLOSED COMPETITION: Competition open only to the members of one organization or group.

competition exclusively among members of a single club (i.e. inter-squad meets), or among two or more USA Swimming member clubs within an organization or group formed for the specific purpose of such competition or series of competitions that are open only to members of that group or organization. Examples of this would include YMCA clubs and leagues consisting of a limited number of USA Swimming clubs within an LSC. It does not include groups or organizations such as an LSC, Zone, Region, or Section within USA Swimming.

Deck Entered: A Meet where entries are accepted on the first or later day of that Meet and subsequently seeded into events.

DUAL or Triangular Meet: A Meet consisting of competition between two (dual) or three (triangular) clubs. COMPETITION: competition between two teams.

EVENT: Any race or series of races in a given stroke and/or distance. For competitive limits, one event <u>is inclusive of equals one preliminary</u>, or one preliminary heat(s) plus its related final(s), or one time final, or one time trial.

HEATS(S): A division of an event in which too many swimmers are entered to compete at one time. (See Preliminary Heats and Timed Final Heats)

Invitational Competition: A Meet for swimmers, organizations, and clubs invited by the host club.

LSC-- (**LOCAL SWIMMING COMMITTEE**): an administrative division of USA Swimming with supervisory responsibilities within certain geographic boundaries designated by USA Swimming.

MEET ANNOUNCEMENT: document setting forth information of the meet events, schedule, and procedures.

Race: Any single swimming competition, i.e., preliminary, final, or timed final.

Registered: Enrolled as an athlete member of USA Swimming and a LSC.

SANCTION: A permit issued by an LSC to a USA Swimming group member to conduct <u>a</u> meet in conformance with all USA Swimming rules in which all participating swimmers are athlete members of USA Swimming, except as provided in 202.3.1.swimming competition within its jurisdiction.

Split Time: A time recorded from official start to completion of an initial distance within a longer event.
