Relay only swimmers are allowed for 13-14 "A" relays only. **Teams may only enter one relay per event if using a relay-only athlete that age group.** To enter a 13-14 relay, your team must have at least one qualified participant in that age group. Relay only swimmers should be included in your initial entry. Additional or alternate relay-only swimmers may be added during the meet, but must be entered in the meet management office at least 30 minutes before the start of the session in which they swim.
