Individual Entry Form, Tide waiver, Individual Badger State Games waiver and mail with fees to the Entry Chairperson no later than 5:00 pm, Tuesday, June 10, 2014.

**Entry Limit:** 

Each swimmer may swim a maximum of 4 individual events per day with a maximum of 8

total individual per swimmer for the meet. 1 relay per day.

Positive check-in is required for swimmers in the 500 free events on Friday afternoon no later than 30 minutes before the meet starts. The 500 free events will be run fastest to

slowest.

**Entry Fees:**

Deck Entries:

Deck entries accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director & only to fill open lanes.

Scratching one event to deck seed in another will not be allowed.

Deck entry fee is \$7.00 per Individual Event.

Deck Entry closes 30 minutes before the start of the meet.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded in all age groups for individual and relay events: Gold, Silver & Bronze. Medals will be presented to athletes during the **Awards** in each session on the pool deck. Ribbons will be awarded 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> for individual events in the 8 & Under, 9-10, and 11-12 age groups.

Format:

8 and Under swimmers may report to the designated staging area. All other swimmers report to the blocks prior to your event. This is a pre-seeded meet. Heat/Events may be combined due to time constraints, but will be awarded separately.

Conduct:

\*All coaches and/or parents/guardian are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. Any violation such as improper behavior or damage to property, etc. may result in removal of the swimmer from the meet and/or disqualification of swimmer's individual events.

\*Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

\* Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged.

Food:

Concessions will be available in the cafeteria. Swimmers are allowed sipper bottles on deck. No food or drink allowed in pool area. Please make sure swimmer's area on deck and in the rest area is picked up after each session.

First Aid Kit:

Please report any injuries to the Lifeguard and to the Meet Director. A First Aid Kit is available through the lifeguard.
