

East Bay Aquatics Association Athlete Code of Conduct

This East Bay Aquatics Association (EBA) code of conduct for athletes is to establish a consistent expectation for athletes' behavior. By signing this code of conduct, I agree to the following statements:

- I will always respect and show courtesy to all my EBA teammates and coaches.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all EBA practices and meets.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for all my EBA teammates.
- I will be respectful of my EBA teammates' feelings and personal space. I understand that any EBA swimmer who exhibits sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- I will attend all EBA team meetings and training sessions unless I am excused by my coach.
- I will show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during EBA practices, USA Swimming Competitions, and EBA team activities.
- I will refrain from foul language, violence, behavior deemed dishonest, offensive, or illegal.
- If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my EBA coach and not approach the official directly.
- I will obey all of USA Swimming's rules and codes of conduct.

I understand that if I violate this code of conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action determined by my EBA coaches and the East Bay Aquatics Association Board of Directors.
