Eligibility:

- A male or female member of the YMCA of South Florida Barracudas Swim team.
- Must be a graduating high school senior who intent is to continue their education in the upcoming Summer or Fall semester at a University, Jr. College or Trade school.
- Must have grade point average (GPA) of 2.7 or higher (Copy of most recent report card required).
- Financial need is a plus but not a must.

Terms:

- This is a onetime scholarship and is not renewable. It will be awarded through a selection process. The selection will be decided by The Fish Family, Head Coach John Spire, Coach Neto Miller, YMCA Executive Director and the Parent Advisory committee. Recipients will be appointed by simple majority vote present at time of selection.
- The value of this scholarship may not exceed \$500.00
- Students must complete application and essay by date due 1st Sunday of April every year.
