



## **September 13, 2022 ATAC Booster Meeting**

The meeting began at 6:06 PM.

Introductions of meeting attendees were made by each person present. President Ralys welcomed those present in attendance to the meeting and thanked them for attending. The meeting minutes from August were approved.

### **Coaches Report**

Coach Terry provided an update on the status of the team by first emphasizing that he recognizes and appreciates that being involved on a swim team is not just an individual effort on the part of the swimmer but that it takes an entire family commitment to promote success of both the individual and the team. Coach Terry also thanked the parents for attending the meeting and for demonstrating their commitment to the swim program. Coach Terry acknowledged feeling encouraged on how the season is starting out with swimmers development and their involvement.

### **Upcoming Meets**

President Ralys provided dates for the upcoming meets this month. Reps were introduced and thanked. There was a form passed around to add any volunteers for awards, hospitality, concessions, annual banquet and corporate sponsorships. For the development distance, timers are still needed. President Ralys suggested for the Panama City meet to have a tent and to welcome ATAC families especially the new families swimming their first away meet. President Ralys inquired on the October 29 date for the pancake breakfast. Coach Terry will confirm with the city. Coach Terry also shared that the Gator Invitational is in Ocala not Gainesville this year. Treasurer Autry shared spirit wear update that personalized swim caps orders are due September 23. He also shared that Cindy will also order caps for the pancake breakfast and red and green meet.

### **Treasurer Report**

The Treasurer reviewed the financial position of the Boosters organization by highlighting income and expenses for the period dating back to the August 23, 2022 booster meeting. Notable income during this period was related to annual team fees collected and merchandise sales. Notable expenditures during this period were clothing/merchandise purchases, meet entry fees, and board insurance premium. The Boosters account has a current balance of \$38,310.45 which puts the Boosters in a sound financial position heading into the Fall/Winter season. A \$1,000 donation from a former swimmer was provided. Treasurer Autry recommended allocating funds towards the filtered water fountain.
