Important Notes

This meet is intended as an opportunity for our novice swimmers to become familiar with meet protocol and to experience the competition environment with only their coaches and teammates. **It is not a sanctioned meet and the times will not count.**

This meet is outdoors and can be hot or rainy. Make sure your swimmers have all of their gear. They will want to have the following:

- Team cap and swimsuit
- Goggles (an extra pair is always a good idea!)
- A couple of towels
- Water bottle to stay hydrated
- Clothes to put on between events, including supportive shoes
- Snacks should be light, healthy food—no junk food!

Depending on the number of athletes attending, we MAY be able to allow spectators on the pool deck. Stay tuned for more information.

Eligibility

Participation is strongly encouraged for all swimmers in the White, Green, YMCA Gator 1 groups, and for swimmers in the Blue and Orange groups who are new to competition. Members of the Sun Country Conditioning group are also encouraged to attend if they plan to eventually move to the O'Connell Center or YMCA.

Entry Limits

Swimmers age 13 & over are limited to two (2) individual events. Swimmers age 12 & under are limited to three (3) individual events. Swimmers may only swim events offered for their age group.

Heat Sheets

Heat sheets showing each swimmer's events, heats, and lanes will be e-mailed and posted 24 hours before the start of the meet. We will NOT have copies of the heat sheet for sale at the meet, so you must print out your own copy.

Camera Zones

Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13, GSC has designated the side course of the pool and team gathering area as the ONLY acceptable "Camera Zones" where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Under NO circumstances can still photographs or videos be taken in the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course while they are in use during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.
