Sanction By: Florida Swimming of USA Swimming # 5223

"In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA-S and FL shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."

Condition of Sanction:

1. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
2. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming OR the competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C).
3. Deck changes are prohibited per rule 202.4.9.1
4. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the USA-S Vice President of Operations,
5. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

COVID19 – Please Read & See further rules in meet information

In applying for this sanction(ed event), the Host, Treasure Coast swimming agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Florida Swimming, the State of Florida and Indian River County. We have taken enhanced health and safety measures – for you and our other guests. You must follow all posted instructions while visiting Treasure Coast Swimming/North County Aquatic Center. Type of Meet: Closed meet /25 yard short course/ timed finals

Dates & Times: **Session 1 11 & over Saturday, October 17th**
Warm up: 7:30 Meet Start 8:30 a.m.
Session 2 10 & under Saturday, October 17th
45 min start after completion of session 1

Running of the meet: There will be one timer per lane, masks are mandatory within pool area. Swimmers can line up 3 heats prior to their race and stand at the designated cones. Cones will be placed 8 ft apart. No Flyover starts. Swimmers exit the pool and walk to the west to the warm down area or return immediately back to their designated team area. All swimmers must be cleared of the area for the next heat to step up. Only 2 swimmers per warm down lane allowed. Swimmers must enter warm down lanes from the south end. Timers will stay seated unless they are standing for timing purposes. All timing equipment will be sanitized between sessions. Sanitation will be available in timing area. Marshalls will always monitor the deck making sure all masks are on, and socially distancing rules are being followed. Anyone not following these rules will be asked to immediately leave the facility. Spectators will be allowed on deck in a designated area to watch swimmer/s. Once a race is completed, we ask that you go back to the parking lot until your swimmer/s is up to swim. While inside the facility, spectators must wear a mask and social distance from one another. Parent/guardian must follow rules or will be asked to leave the facility.

Pool Specifications: Water depth at the starting end is a minimum feet 8 inches at both ends. Outdoor 8 Lane 25 yard pool Non turbulent lane lines 25 yd. Warm up/warm down available

Timing Equipment: Colorado Timing System and display scoreboard

Warm Up: Session 1, 2 7:30 am
Session 2 guaranteed 45 minutes at end of session 1

Teams will be assigned lanes for warm up. No more than 5 swimmers per lane.
Three swimmers starting from north end and two from the south end.

Eligibility: Open to currently USA swimming registered swimmers. Entries will be limited to 150 swimmers excluding TCSC.

Entry limit: Swimmers are limited to 5 events per day.

Seeding: Use 25-yard short course times. Conversions using the formula in the 2020 Florida swimming handbook may be used for entry and seeding purposes. Meet will be pre-seeded.

Scratches: No penalty for scratching on the block

Entries: Entries must be in USA swimming SDIF or Hy-tek CL2 format submitted on a Hy=tek disk, or sent by email using Hy-tek team manager. Corrupted, unreadable, or incorrectly formatted files must be corrected within 24 hours. Errors in entries submitted electronically are the responsibility of the applicant. Please list all attending coaches and contact phone numbers in the body of the email. Confirmation will be sent via email upon receipt. Entries will be accepted via electronic mail attachment to Tcscswim@comcast.net Free text email will not be accepted. A signed hard copy printout also serves as proof of entry. The legal name and current USA swimming registration number for each swimmer must be listed on the entry file.

Representative: Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach, who will check with the referee about any matter pertaining to the meet, may be given to the referee. For each team, the coach and that person will only be recognized. All swimmers must be represented by a certified USA swimming member coach.

Identification & Check in: Coaches and Officials shall sign in wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location at all times while on deck during the swim meet or prove current registration with Deck Pass.

Rules: Current USA swimming rules will govern the meet. Safety rules, as outlined by USA Swimming, and recommended by the head marshal, will be in effect during all warm ups and in all warm up areas.

Camera Zones: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.13

Meet Management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zones" at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a competitor in a race may be taken. Acceptable "Camera Zone include, but are not limited to the side course of a pool, team gathering areas, concession area, turn-end of competition course when not in use as a "start-end," etc. Meet Management shall also designate "Non-Camera Zones." Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course(s) while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2.

Directions: From 1-95 exit 156 Sebastian/Fellsmere (512). Turn east, drive approximately 2 miles and the pool will be on the left hand side of 512.

WARM-UP SCHEDULE

No equipment permitted

Teams will be assigned warm up lanes. No more than 5 swimmers per lane.

Swimmers must enter the water feet first with at least one hand in contact with the pool deck except when executing a controlled racing start, supervised by a coach.

COVID FACILITY GUIDELINES AND RULES
FOR ALL PARENTS, SWIMMERS & OFFICIALS

1. **Ingress: All participants, coaches and Officials will enter via the North west gate.**
2. **Egress: All participants, coaches and Officials will exit via the South West gate.**
3. **All participants, coaches and officials will wear masks while at the facility. Swimmers may take them off for warm up, warm down, and races.**
4. **Locker rooms are for bathroom use only. No changing or showering in locker rooms.**
5. **All teams must sit socially distanced 6ft apart. Teams may not comingle with other teams.**
6. **Spectators will be allowed into the pool in a designated area to watch their swimmers particular race. When the race is over please leave the facility and wait for the next race. All spectators must wear a mask and socially distance form one another.**
7. **There will not be any concessions or hospitality at the facility. Bring your own and do not share with any others.**
8. **The team areas will be designated on opposite sides of the pool. Coaches will have an area and will be socially distanced from each other.**
9. **Sanitation stations will be set up for all participants, coaches, and officials to use.**
10. **Events will be announced so parents waiting in the parking lot will be alerted and be able to enter the facility in time to watch their swimmer/s.**
11. **There will be deck monitor making sure all masks are on, and socially distancing rules are being followed. Anyone not following these rules will be asked to leave the facility.**
