

Windermere Laker Locker Room Policy

1. Athletes are not allowed to be in the locker room without supervision
2. Athletes shall maintain appropriate personal boundaries and abstain from inappropriate actions that include, but are not limited to the following: horseplay, inappropriate physical contact, or throwing of objects/projectiles
3. Food, gum, beverages and glass items are prohibited in the locker room
4. Show respect at all times - no derogatory comments, bullying or hazing. Behavior of this nature should be reported to the coach or teacher immediately. Any behavior intended to embarrass or humiliate another is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.
5. Keep the locker room clean - discard all trash in trash cans. Leave the locker room cleaner than when you arrived.
6. Do not take items that do not belong to you. If it appears an item has been left behind, give it to a coach or teacher so they can return it to the owner.
7. Do not linger in the locker rooms. The locker room is a place to get ready and change. It is not a social place.
8. Athletes are responsible for the safety of their personal belongings.
9. Cell phones and tablets (iPads, Surface, etc.) shall remain in backpacks at all times. Photos and videos are strictly prohibited in all locker rooms, regardless of the device used to capture images, sound, or video. Use of cell phones, cameras, video recorders, tablets, or any other device to record or transfer images in a locker room will result in disciplinary action.
