

WRA PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Warner Robins Aquanauts may wish to take photographs (individual and in groups) of swimmers under the age of 18 that may include your child during their membership in the club. All photos will be taken and published in line with club policy, as outlined below, and will only be used in the course of usual swim team business, including on the team website, in newsletters, and to the team's social media pages.

A parent or guardian has a right of refusal to have children photographed. The exercise of this right of refusal cannot be used as grounds for refusing entry into a swimming practice or competition. Consent to take and use photographs can be refused in writing, by emailing assistant@wraswim.com. Consent is implied by your participation with the team, unless and until it is specifically refused in writing.

All photographs must observe generally accepted standards of decency in particular:

- o Action shots will be a celebration of the sporting activity and not a sexualized image in a sporting context.
- o Action shots will not be taken or retained where the photograph reveals a torn or displaced swimsuit.
- o Photographs will not be taken from behind swimming blocks at the start of a race or exhibit a child climbing out of the swimming pool.
- o Photographs will not be taken in locker-rooms or bathrooms.
