Dropping time has become a way of life here at AQUA. That's just the way we like it. All the kids (and young adults) have done a great job this summer.

Meet attendance and performances have been the best in our 2-year history. The swimmers and coaches should be justifiably proud of AQUA's team accomplishments.

AQUA swimmers improved times in 66% of their swims at the A&M meet in mid-June. Swimmer of the Meet, with 100% best times in all six of his races, was **Cole Cragin**. Other swimmers with 100% best times were **Noelle Gilman and Katharine Silkowski, Ellen Lobb and Caroline McElhany**. There were three new T16 times recorded by the 10 & under girls 200 free relay of **Caroline, Julia Sepulveda, Adriana Sepulveda and Ellen**, and individually by **Caroline McElhany** in the 200 and 400 free. There were five new TAGS times by **Julia** in the 100 breast, **Mark Grijalva** in the 400 free, **Aaron Olszeski** in the 400 free and **Adam Olszeski** in the 400 free and the 100 back. In addition, there were 32 new team records set collectively by **Christie Latimer, Kacie Baker, Noelle Gilman, Diana Sepulveda, Aaron Olszeski, Adam Olszeski, John Christopher, John McElhany, Kim Anton, Cole Cragin, Lynn Fahey, Caroline McElhany, Ellen Lobb, Adriana Sepulveda, Julia Sepulveda,**

Jared Schneider and Katharine Silkowski. WOW! As impressive as that number is, it should not be a surprise when our swimmers drop time as they do. Thanks also go out to AQUA parents who not only filled AQUA timer assignments but also chairs of other teams, and helped keep the meet moving smoothly.

At the DADS BB & Under meet June 28-30, AQUA swimmers improved in 72% of their efforts. Swimmer of the Meet, with 100% best times in all seven of his events, was **Taylor Cryan**. Other swimmers with 100% best times were **Lauren Barr, Stephen Sun, Diana Sepulveda, Jennifer Joines, Adriana Sepulveda and Julia Sepulveda. Julia, Adriana, Caroline Baliker, Kim Anton, Noelle Gilman and Cameron Dyer** collectively recorded seven new A times at the meet, and **Taylor** added swims that helped qualify the 11-12 boys 200 and 400 medley relays for TAGS. One new team record was set by **Noelle Gilman** in the 200 breast. That's another awesome meet, this time on a very hectic and soggy weekend. Way to go, AQUA! 🐬

Know the Gulf recruiting rules

However, there is a right way and a wrong way to grow. Let's allow our results *in the water* grow the team. Please avoid making (or initiating) contact with other known USA registered swimmers about AQUA. If they ask about AQUA, it's ok to answer. We should be careful to avoid situations that could be considered unsolicited recruiting, particularly with summer league teammates.

While we have not heard of any problem situations recently, others in the area may approach you promoting another team. This practice is discouraged by Gulf Swimming and it should be reported. If you have been approached in a manner you think may be a violation of these Gulf Swimming rules, please contact a coach or a Board member.
