

Bathroom Monitor

Age Requirement: 18+

Timeline: Must arrive based on Meet Timeline schedule.

Description: Ensure there is never one on one contact with a single adult and a single swimmer. Bathroom Monitors & Safety Marshals report to Meet Marshals.

The main responsibilities of this position include:

- Checking In At the Volunteer Table and Attending the Pre-meet Meeting
 - The Meet Marshals will run the meeting.
 - You report to the Meet Marshals.
- Two (2) Adults
 - If minors are in the restroom, accompany an adult, if they are the only adult, entering the locker room. A minor should never be inside the restroom/locker rooms with only 1 adult.
- Photography
 - Signs shall be posted on the bathroom/locker room doors advising that phones shall not be used inside these areas. Ensure and be on the lookout for adults using their phones when they enter the restroom (no photography permitted).
- Phone Usage
 - Bathroom Monitors should avoid the temptation of playing on their phones.
 - Accidents can occur within the blink of an eye. It's fine to glance at Meet Mobile for your swimmers results or answer a text from a child asking for concessions money or the oh so common "where are you?!" but avoid or minimize phone usage. In addition, Bathroom Monitors must not use iPods, ear buds, or headphones to listen to music, podcast, etc. during the duration of the session so you can pay attention to the swim meet.
- If a swimmer or parent is not responding to corrections from the Bathroom Monitor, they should find a Meet Marshal and they will step in to assist.
 - If a swimmer or parent is still not correcting the action, Meet Marshal will report to the Meet Director and Referee.
- Hydration
 - All Bathroom Monitors will be offered water by a Hospitality drink runner on a regular basis.
 - You are important and we want you safe. If Bathroom Monitors are thirsty or have not been offered water, let the Meet Director or a member of Hospitality know so they can accommodate your request immediately.
- List of additional items requiring Bathroom Monitors intervention:
 - No running or horseplay near and inside the bathroom/locker room area.
 - No loitering/playing inside the bathroom/locker room area.

- Check Out at the End of Shift
 - Bathroom Monitors shall check in with the Meet Marshal at the end of the shift. Shift will end once all events as well as swimmers cooling down at the pool and changing at the locker/bathroom area are completely done.
