Parent Meeting Questions

- Where will the practices be the week of May 25 – May 31? Practices will be held at Swim Houston Aquatics Center (Location: 8454 W Airport Blvd, Houston, TX 77071)
- Where will the practices be after the week of May 25 – May 31? We will decide if we go back to Shac on Thursday, May 28, for the week of June 1st – 7th.
- Will ESA's find a local pool? Yes, Coach Pink has been working diligently to talk with local pools, and we hope to find one within two weeks, so we don't have to travel.
- When will ESA be back at AHS and SCHS? Honestly, we don't know yet; however, we are hopeful around July, if not earlier!
- Is it safe for my swimmer to start swimming again? Yes, we believe that it is safe to start swimming again and USA Swimming has given all clubs the go ahead to practice again!
- How will practices be conducted to ensure that social distancing is happening at practices? USA swimming has given all clubs an outline of how workouts will be done. There will never be more than five people in a short course lane. There will never be more than 6 in a Long Course pool!
- Will I be able to sit on deck? No, we are asking parents to wait in cars for pick and drop off!
- Will I be able to drop off my swimmer early? No, Athletes will not be permitted to enter the building or pool deck 5 minutes before their scheduled practice. If they arrive early, they must wait in their car until the appropriate time to enter the building or pool deck!
- Will there be a Long Course Tags / Age Group Champs or Senior Meet? No, as of right now, all Gulf Swimming Meets are off the table!
- How do I sign up for make-up practices? To ensure that we don't overfill the make-up practices, we are asking you to use [signup.com](https://www.signup.com) to list if you are coming to the make-up group!
- How will we get any new information on signup or practices? The weekly chlorine will start this Saturday!
- Will my swimmer be able to change or shower at the pool? No, please have all athletes come prepared to swim when they leave the house.

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- Will my swimmer be able to use the restrooms during practice in case of emergency?
Yes, we will allow one swimmer only to use the restroom in case of emergency.
- What will happen if someone test positive for COVID -19 in our membership? The individual should let the staff know immediately! The individual or individuals swimming on either side of that athlete will be expected to self-quarantine for 14 day and/or receive a negative COVID-19 Test [we will be assigning lanes for all practices so we are clear what athletes may be impacted by this]. The facility will be shut down for no less than 24 hours to deep clean.
