- IASI SANCTION** IA-22-085. Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Iowa Swimming, Inc. (IASI).
- AVAILABILITY** The ability to conduct time trials is dependent upon availability within the Championship timeline. At the discretion of the Meet Referee, Time Trials may only be conducted if time permits. Time constraints may limit the amount of time trials offered each day. **There is no guarantee Time Trials will be available.**
- ENTRIES** Time Trial registration will open at 12:00 pm on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 for electronic entries in a format compatible with Hy-Tek Meet Manager and at the Clerk of Course table for manual entries beginning at 8:00 am on the day of the Time Trial session. Registration for each day of Time Trials will close at 10:15am.

- Entry fees must be paid in cash or check payable to **Panther Aquatics Club** by the deadline for Time Trial registration for the day. If Time Trials are not held due to time constraints, entry fees will be returned.
- PROCEDURE**
1. Only swimmers entered in individual events or relay events are permitted to participate in Time Trials.
 2. Swimmers are limited to a maximum of one (1) time trial per day. The combination of individual events and time trial events cannot exceed three per day.
 3. Time Trials will be limited to a maximum of one noncontiguous hour per day.
 4. Time Trials will begin no later than 10 minutes after the final heat of the morning preliminary session or after the final heat of the afternoon timed finals session. Time Trials are not permitted prior to the morning preliminary session or following the evening finals session.
 5. Time Trials may be conducted at additional times throughout the day, at the discretion of the Meet Referee, so long as the Championship timeline is not adjusted to accommodate the Time Trials.

6. Only the individual and relay events for each age category that are offered in the Championship will be offered as Time Trials.
7. Priority will be given to the events offered in the Championship for that day, with the 800 Freestyle, 1500 Freestyle, and 800 Freestyle Relay receiving the least priority regardless of day.
8. The order of events for Time Trials will be determined by the Meet Referee following registration for each day.
9. Swimmers must provide their own timers (required) and lap counters (if desired) for distance events.
