



There have been several parents still parking, dropping off, and picking up their swimmers by the pool doors. **As the emails, have stated, we cannot have cars parked or waiting by the shop doors or on the drive between the softball fields and the building.** There is a serious safety concern for swimmers walking to the parking lot. Please see the above map on where to park and drop off/pick up swimmers.

We encourage ALL parents to walk their swimmer into and out of the pool area to ensure they get to and from practice safely. As stated on our safety policy, swimmers are not permitted to leave the

building unless accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. The coaches and board are too busy to police this policy; therefore, it is the parents' responsibility to assure their children's safety.

If you see cars parked by the shop garages, do not park there yourself, they can be cars for the high school shop, maintenance crew, or parents from the high school swim team. The building maintenance department stores the snow removal equipment in this area and needs access to the garages.

If you are coming at the first practice time when the high school swim team is getting out, their parents might be waiting for them in this area near the doors. We do not have control over the high school team parking there. So, please use caution when dropping off your swimmer and cars pulling out of this area.

Also, there will be on occasion, board members or other volunteers unloading their cars near the pool door for special events, meets or bringing in items/equipment for the team. Those cars will only be there temporarily and will be moved after unloading all items.

We thank everyone who is already following the parking directions. We hope anyone that is still parking near the garage doors, take this seriously, not only for your swimmer's safety but every swimmer's safety. If we see you parking in the designated no parking area, we will ask you to move your car.
