



Parent/Guardian Volunteer Policy

Welcome to the Stingrays family! Unlike other clubs in which your child may participate, with us you'll become an active and vital part of the team. Parents are in charge of running our **home** swim meets; it takes an average of 50+ volunteers to host an efficient meet. If your child is swimming in a meet at our Y, you are expected to provide an adult volunteer. Volunteer jobs are (a) easy, (b) varied, (c) educational and (d) a great way to meet other families! Plus, it makes the time go by fast.

Volunteer job descriptions are available under "Documents" on our team website. Job sign-up takes place online on a first-come, first-served basis, so sign up early if there is a specific job you prefer. There are some jobs—such as greeter, concessions and ribbons—that you can do while watching your small children, and other jobs (bullpen, timer, etc.) that you cannot. At the same time you sign your child up to swim at a meet through our team website, you will also sign up to volunteer. All volunteers must check in at the Volunteer Table as soon as you arrive at the meet. If you did not sign up to volunteer in advance, you will receive a job assignment.
