1. Meet packets have been completed for Short course and Long Course Championship Meet Packets (Regional, Age Group and Senior). The library is now complete for the meet packets. They include short course and long course, 8 lane vs 10 lane, Wisconsin, Indiana, and Illinois. We will now just add the published time standards as an insert along with the published Regional assigned sites to the packets. This will allow us to choose the correct packet depending on location and update only a few items instead of having to re-write the packet.
 - a) This also includes Meet Management files. It is now the Senior or Age group committee's responsibility to use the correct packet and file so we no longer have mix ups
2. Pam and I have completed the Meet Director Manual. We have also run 2 Meet Director clinics. We are still working on the certification process but, our goal is to have those who go through the clinic to become certified. Also, only those that are certified will be able to act as a Meet Director in a Championship meet. This will allow for a consistent way for championship meets to be run.
3. Officials committee has added the requirements for NCAA certified only or to also add NCAA certification if you are already a USA certified official.
 - i) The committee is also reviewing all Reciprocal certifications (YMCA) should we be adding NCAA, IHSA. Can we do this with one Policy versus 3 or 4.
4. I will be creating a Certification for the position of Chief Judge to match that of USA swimming.

5. Please remember beginning on Jan 1st, 2015 the Rule of deck changing will be consistent across all LSCs. At the Oct 2014 USA HOD Decking changing will be Prohibited.
