Here is a list of mandatory certifications:

Coaches: MAAPP, Racing Start certification, Concussion Protocol Training, USADA Coach Advantage Training, Athlete Protection Training, Background Check, STSC and CPR.

Athletes: MAAPP, APT (18+)

Officials: MAAPP, Concussion Protocol Training, APT, Background Check

Non-Athlete Member: MAAPP, APT, Background Check

USA Clubs (document recording/retention responsibility): MAAPP, Racing Start Certification, Report of Occurrence.

Please note that concussion training will not have an expiration date, but that different LSC's might require that the class be done in the last 3 years, for example. Please use the NFHS for concussion training instead of the CDC site. They are the same, but the NFHS is searchable for your certificate should you not print it right away.

USA Swimming Membership status is dependent on compliance with all of the above.
