

2021-2022 WCS Meet Entry and Volunteer Expectations:

Our overall programming and fee structure is based on our successful hosting of 3 larger swim meet events through the winter season that generate revenue for our club to offset pool rental and other essential team costs. These meets have historically been hosted at our own WCCHS POOL in the winter season:

FALL FLING – in mid November

POLAR BEAR CLASSIC – in early January

FEB FRENZY – in mid February

In this fundraising model – through charging individual event and relay entry fees, admission charges, and concession sales, etc. we can sustain a high-quality program with lower overall costs to all our member families. Our program is a competitive swim team and therefore we encourage and expect scaled commitments from ALL our members and their families based on their training levels within our program.

Along with EXPECTED participation in these 3 hosted meets we will offer multiple local, and travel meet options for interested families throughout the season.

Whenever you have a swimmer in a meet session you as a family unit are expected to volunteer 1 adult in one of several simple tasks needed for the meet to operate safely. These assigned shifts are essential to operating a meet and coincide with the sessions your swimmer(s) are entered. All volunteer roles allow for you to observe your swimmer race.

The following (by training level) are the swimmer meet entry expectations, volunteer commitments and fees for not meeting these team expectations... If you volunteer for all the sessions your swimmer(s) are entered – you will only pay their entry fees for assigned events/meets.

With hosting these 3 planned meets as our team's FUND-RAISERS there are participation requirements...

EVERY swim family will be billed at these MINIMUMS based on their training level after the offered meets.

Participation in more meets, additional individual and or relay events will increase overall meet entry charges.

Meet fee prices are individually set by each meet host. [Meet fees are non-refundable after published entry deadlines.](#)

Any additional fundraiser events will be OPTIONAL yet HIGHLY ENCOURAGED for specific special equipment purchases

BLUE SHARK:

Swimmer: 2 events each day Saturday and Sunday of each HOME ISI meet listed above, additional home meets ENCOURAGED, away/travel meets with coach permission

Parent: Volunteer EACH session your swimmer is in ANY meet (there is fee of \$60 for each non-volunteered session @ home meets) – at away meets agree to volunteer time 1x60 minute shift each session – (a non-volunteer fee for away meets is \$20)

Family: In Kind donation of \$20 toward concessions/hospitality items for EACH of the 3 home ISI meets listed above

LEOPARD SHARK:

Swimmer: 3 events each day Saturday and Sunday of each HOME ISI meet listed above, additional home meets ENCOURAGED, away meets (local/travel) OPTIONAL

Parent: Volunteer EACH session your swimmer is in ANY meet (there is fee of \$60 for each non-volunteered session @ home meets) -- at away meets agree to volunteer time 1x60 minute shift each session – (a non-volunteer fee for away meets is \$20)

Family: In Kind donation of \$20 toward concessions/hospitality items for EACH of the 3 home ISI meets listed above

TIGER SHARK:

Swimmer: 1 event Friday, 3 events each day Saturday and Sunday of each HOME ISI meet listed above, additional local home/away meets EXPECTED, Travel meets ENCOURAGED

Parent: Volunteer EACH session your swimmer is in ANY meet (there is fee of \$60 for each non-volunteered session @ home meets) – at away meets agree to volunteer time 1x60 minute shift each session – (a non-volunteer fee for away meets is \$20)

Family: In Kind donation of \$20 toward concessions/hospitality items for EACH of the 3 home ISI meets listed above

GREY SHARK:

Swimmers: 1 event Friday, 4 events each day Saturday and Sunday of each HOME ISI meet listed above, additional local home/away meets EXPECTED, travel meets ENCOURAGED

Parent: Volunteer EACH session your swimmer is in ANY meet (there is fee of \$60 for each non-volunteered session @ home meets) – at away meets agree to volunteer time 1x60 minute shift each session – (a non-volunteer fee for away meets is \$20)

Family: In Kind donation of \$20 toward concessions/hospitality items for EACH of the 3 home ISI meets listed above

WHITE SHARK

Swimmer: 1 event Friday, 4 events each day Saturday and Sunday of each HOME ISI meet listed above, additional local home/away and travel meets EXPECTED

Parent: Volunteer EACH session your swimmer is in ANY meet (there is fee of \$60 for each non-volunteered session @ home meets) – at away meets agree to volunteer time 1x60 minute shift each session – (a non-volunteer fee for away meets is \$20)

Family: In Kind donation of \$20 toward concessions/hospitality items for EACH of the 3 home ISI meets listed above

OFFICIALS:

Any WCS parent that goes through the additional commitment to our sport and is certified as an ISI swimming official... will be reimbursed for associated training, certification, and non-athlete membership costs. Likewise, they will be provided hospitality at all meet sessions worked as a meet volunteer and the family is excused from away meet timing for any away meets that a family member officiated a session.

AWAY MEET TIMING:

As listed above each family will be slated to cover timing in approximately 60 minute intervals of timing a lane for away meets - this is applicable only when our club is assigned by the host team – Coach Dan will maintain a rolling list and as you work any away meet assignments you will go to the bottom of the rolling roster.
