Location and Pool: Indoor 8 lane 25-yard pool. The competition pool ranges in depth from 12 ft. deep at the start end to 4 ft. deep at the turn end. The pool has Kiefer lane lines and a Daktronics timing system with display board. Beep horn systems with strobes will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Meet Schedule: Warm-ups 8 am and Meet Start 9 am.

St. Charles Aquatics reserves the right to modify session start times once entries are completed to provide the best possible competition environment for the athletes.

Eligibility: Only athletes registered with USA Swimming, pursuant to Article 302 prior to final entry are eligible. Entries listed as “Registration applied for” will not be accepted. Registration forms can be obtained from ISI: www.ilswim.org. A swimmers age for the competition is his/her age as of the first date of the meet.



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- Entry Deadlines:** Entries will not be accepted before Friday, November 5, 2021 at 8:00 a.m., and will be accepted until the timeline is at capacity or November 28, 2021 at noon, whichever is earlier. Only entries received by e-mail will be accepted. Entries will be on a first-received, first-entered basis. Entries received before the due date will be rejected.
- Entries, Forms and Fees:** All entries shall comply with current USA Swimming and ISI rules. Registration numbers, age, first name, middle initial and last name must appear on all entries. All entries must be submitted from a USA Swimming certified coach. Enter swimmers at their short course yard times to assure proper seeding. Seeding will be formatted SCY/LCM/SCM/NT. Computerized entries from Hy-Tek's team Manager are preferred. You may e-mail entries to Jon Cabel at swim@stcswim.com. Please send the following complete information:
1) A copy of your entry; 2) Signed release form; 3) Payment for meet.
Entry fees are \$5.00 for each individual event and \$10 per relay. A facility fee of \$15 per athlete will be assessed. Please note there will be no charge for admissions or heat sheets to spectators. A \$2.00 surcharge per swimmer is being collected by ISI. These surcharges must be included with the entry check. Make checks payable to: St. Charles Aquatics.
- Entry Limits:** Swimmers are limited to 4 individual events and two relays. If the Individual is entered in more than 4 individual events, they will be removed from later events until the rule is satisfied. Every effort will be made to accommodate all swimmers. St. Charles reserves the right to swim their swimmers. St. Charles Swim Team reserves the right to limit relays to meet timeline requirements. Refunds will be issued in limited events. Deck Entries may be allowed at the Meet Referee's discretion.
- Event Format:** All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest.
- Athletes with Disabilities:** In accordance with USA Swimming Rules; Articles 105 and 202.1.13, the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. It is the responsibility of the coaches or swimmers to contact the Meet Referee, prior to competition, with specific requests.
- Coaches:** All coaches must check in. A coach's packet will be available on the pool deck at coach check-in. You must present either a USA Swimming coaches registration card or Deck Pass. Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club always has proper supervision.
- Spectator Information:** Presuming no change in state or local guidance, or facility issues, spectators will be allowed at this meet. Admissions and heat sheets are included in the facility fee. Heat sheets will be made available without charge in an electronic format on the meet website and through Meet Mobile. Concessions will be available for sale.



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- Warm-ups:** Warm-up periods will be conducted under Illinois Swimming Rules and Policies. The Meet Referee and Meet Director will provide format as needed. All safety rules for the warm-up period must be observed.
- Check-in:** THIS IS A PRE-SEEDED MEET – NO CHECK IN IS REQUIRED.
- Results:** Results will be posted at the facility as the meet progresses. Electronic result files will be emailed to coaches following the meet. Meet Mobile will be active throughout the meet.
- Awards:** Awards for individual events will be given for places 1 to 16 for 8-year-old, 7-year-old and 6 & Under age groups. Awards for relays will be given for places 1 through 3.
- Officials:** USA Swimming officials who would like to work the meet should contact the Meet Referee. All officials must present current, valid USA and Illinois Swimming credentials. An Official's meeting will be held 40 minutes before each session's scheduled start time.
- Meet Conduct:**
- This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Illinois Swimming, Inc. All USA Swimming and ISI rules apply including safety rules, which will be strictly enforced. The St. Charles Swim Team will strictly enforce the USA Swimming Swimmer and Parental Code of Conduct. Any violation will result in ejection from the meet.
 - All questions concerning the meet after the start of the meet should be directed to the Meet Referee.
 - Only USA Swimming registered Coaches and Officials will be allowed on deck, and registration cards must be displayed while on deck.
 - Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
 - All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Illinois Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Illinois and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Illinois Swimming competition to promote such competitions.
 - All applicable adults participating or associated with the respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledges that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed Athlete Protection Training prior to the entry deadline.



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Parking and Directions: SCST Parking Signs will be posted outside the facilities directing swim meet traffic to the appropriate parking lot and entrance.

Enter through Door 1 at the north end of the building. Parking is available in the adjacent lot. We must enforce these rules to continue to use these facilities. Thank you for your cooperation.
