Meeting Notes from Parent Meeting on 5/10/2010

- The JAWS Board of Directors Elections was held on April 25th. We had around a 50% return rate with election ballots, 43 Club members voted. All Board Members were elected with 75% of the vote or higher. 2010-2011 JAWS Board of Directors: President Kelley Fleck, VP Tracy Mehringer, Treasurer- Brenda Mehringer, Secretary Christine Brinkman, Board Member- Angie Erny, Board Member Dave Head, Board Member- Julie Ammon, Board Member- Stacy Nolan, Board Member- Ed Pacey, Board Member Kristy Vaughn.
- The Club has put in a bid application to host the 2011 Divisional Meet. We do have some stiff competition this year, with NSC and Donner who have also applied to host this meet. Cross your fingers!!
- JAWS has started it long-course season with 62 registered swimmers for the summer the summer season. This is about 20 swimmers over last summer season. Our swim lesson program continues to go strong. We are at 109 participants and still have one 10- lesson session to go with registrations still coming in. We are already 10% over in registrations than what we did last year. We expect we will reach full capacity with lessons by the end of June.
- Review of the Club-Interscholastic Cooperative Initiative See attached document. This is an
 outline of how Club and High School will work together to support kids that are swimming both
 Club and High School seasons. Coach Ed, Kristy Vaughn and Kristen Gutgsell have worked on this
 over the last several months.
- Review of the JAWS Parent Satisfaction Survey that was conducted during a 2 week period. We had 42 surveys that were completed by the parent membership. Attached are the results of the survey and the identified areas for improvement in the four core areas. Overall, the results were very favorable!! "Thank You", to all the parents who participated in the survey, your feedback is important! The Parent Satisfaction Survey will be done on an annual basis every spring.
- Over this past season, the Board has been working on the "Club Recognition Program" through USA Swimming. The Club Recognition Program is a voluntary program to recognize clubs that demonstrate a commitment to long term club growth, development and stability. Clubs must meet markers measuring business and organizational success, parent and volunteer development, coach development and education, and athlete development and performance. Clubs are ranked Level 1 through Level 4. The Club has met the requirements for "Level 1" and has submitted the request and is now waiting for approval. Only around 30% of all the swim clubs in Indiana have achieved Level 1 or higher.
