

LAKE CENTRAL BARRACUDAS (LCB) LOCKER ROOM POLICIES

LCB has staggered practices, with different groups arriving and departing throughout the day. It is therefore not practical to constantly monitor locker rooms and changing areas over this extended course of time. While we do not post staff, coaches, parents, or other adults inside or at the doors of the locker rooms and changing areas, we can make occasional sweeps of these areas. Only Coaches conduct these sweeps, with women checking on female locker rooms, and men checking on male locker rooms.

1. PARENTS are not permitted to enter the locker rooms. The Age Group swimmers will use the General Locker Room for evening practices. The Age Group Coaches will review this policy with the Age Group Swimmers. They will also advise the Age Group swimmers to immediately notify any Coach if they encounter ANY adult in the General Locker Room that is not a Coach. I also would like to ask the parents of the Age Group Swimmers to reinforce this particular policy. Violation of this policy will result in suspension and possible termination from the Lake Central Barracudas

2. Locker room use is a revocable privilege if LCB swimmers demonstrate inappropriate behavior while using the locker rooms as defined or acknowledged by one of the following: USA Swimming Code of Conduct, the USA Swim Safe Sport Handbook, the LCB Board of Directors, or LCB Coaching staff. Please note that the locker rooms are not private or exclusive to The Barracudas and its Age Group swimmers. Locker room policies are in effect for use by club members to provide guidelines for use only. Parents shall assume all risk for all use of the locker rooms including, but not limited to, scheduled practices, private lessons, and meets.

USE OF CELL PHONES AND OTHER MOBILE RECORDING DEVICES

Cell phones and other mobile devices with recording capabilities, including voice recording, still cameras and video cameras increase the risk for different forms of misconduct in locker rooms and changing areas. The USA Swimming Athlete Protection Policies prohibit the use of such devices in the locker room or other changing area: 305.3 Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone camera, is not allowed in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

This policy is being adopted to protect the rights, privileges and most importantly, the privacy of ALL swimmers.
