



Volunteering with the Barracudas

Volunteering with the Barracudas is easy. You will be sent an email with explicit instructions prior to the opening of the first volunteer sign up. One of the biggest questions that arise from the process is: "what job do I pick?" Below is a quick snapshot of common jobs that are typically available at the meets.

Admissions: Will sit at the admissions table to sell wristbands and heat sheets, and provide general assistance to meet patrons.

Admissions/Runner: Will start at admissions, but transition to running which includes performing various tasks, such as posting official results on the wall.

Announcer: Will announce important information on the overhead system, such as events, heats, and top places in each event.

Clerk of Course: Organizes and assists 8 & under swimmers with lane assignments

Concessions: Works in concession stand

Deck Door Monitor: Sits at deck door to ensure that only credentialed adults (no parents) are on deck & that no food is carried out.

Deck Traffic Monitor (Human Stop Sign): Prevents swimmers from crossing path of starting official at the beginning of races.

Glass Monitor: Monitors balcony to ensure that all spectators are allowed the same view

Hospitality: Helps to set up and monitor the coach/official hospitality suite

Locker Room Door Monitor: Sits by locker room doors to be sure that ONLY swimmers enter.

Timer: Uses stopwatch and plunger to capture and record the times from the events. A timer "cheat sheet" is located on the website.
