

# MSC SENIOR HONOR CODE

The following code is in effect throughout the calendar year. Additionally, anyone who, in the opinion of the coach or coaches, acts inappropriately will be subject to the three step discipline policy.

- 1) All MSC team members will have the appropriate behavior upon entering the Aquatic Center in the hallway and locker rooms.

No horseplay of any kind will be tolerated and the discipline policy will begin immediately.

The locker rooms will also be supervised looking for the following: moderate music (or this privilege will no longer exist), appropriate individual language, appropriate storage and locking of lockers, and turning off shower water, etc. A reasonable time to exit the aquatic center at the end of morning practice is 30 minutes on all days and 15 minutes after the conclusion of afternoon practice. A reasonable time to exit the locker rooms at the start of practice is about 5-10 minutes.

The pool deck will also be supervised looking for the following: athletes not on the diving boards or in the timing tower/timing room/equipment room/offices without permission from a coach, appropriate individual language, no equipment horseplay and pick up of equipment and daily practice/workout papers. Each lane is responsible for their own items and we will work together to help each other out if somebody forgets.

- 2) All MSC team members should be respectful of their peers, coaches, and parents. Any MSC team member not acting in such a manner will be asked to change or stop that behavior. If that team member fails to comply, they will be asked to leave and disciplinary procedures will follow.
- 3) #1 and 2 above also apply at all home and away swim meet competitions. All MSC team members will travel as individual families in order to compete with the best and further strive to better competition. Everyone is expected to behave in an exemplary manner.
- 4) The consumption or purchase of alcohol, smoking or chewing tobacco, or use of any other illegal drug or USOC banned substance of any kind will not be allowed. In addition, any team member found or suspected to be in the presence of others (regardless of team affiliation) partaking in any of the above activities will be subject to the same punishments and probable expulsion from MSC.

## Discipline Policy

1. Phone call to all parents involved with documentation.
2. Conference (s) with all swimmers and parents involved, and at least two coaches with documentation.
3. Conference (s) with all parents involved and further disciplinary measures will result.
