Eight-lane 25 yard pool with Daktronics timing systems and 8 lane scoreboard. Balcony seating for spectators overlooks pool. Concessions will be available. The diving well will be available to warm-up and cool-down.

The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 5.0 feet at each end of the pool.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Facility Notes:

We are renting this facility, and we are expected to treat it as if it were our own. Swimmers, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators must abide by these rules:

- Keep all trash picked up
- Only coaches, athletes, officials, and volunteers will be allowed entry to the pool deck. As per insurance regulations, no parents (except volunteers) will be allowed on deck.
- ZSC will provide a live-stream of the meet on our YouTube channel.
- No camping in the spectator area or hallways.

- Anyone caught abusing the facilities will be asked to leave the meet IMMEDIATELY and the team will be billed for any damages caused by their swimmers!

Eligibility: Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming prior to the competition (202.3.4B). Age as of December 3, 2022 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet (205.2.2).

***Indiana Swimming does not process on-site athlete registration.

Admission: No admission fees will be charged.

Hospitality: We will provide some on site hospitality for coaches and officials. Please bring your own water bottle to be refilled at our on-deck water bottle filler station.

Concessions: No concessions will be provided at this event.

Parking: Parking will be free. Please park on southside of the building and enter through door #7 for the Aquatic Center.

Meet Format: This is a timed finals meet and will be pre-seeded for each session.

Meet Schedule: Saturday AM Girls 12&Under Events: 8am Warm-up, 8:45am Start
Saturday PM Boys 12&Under Events: Noon Warm-up, 12:45pm Start

Entry Limitations: Each swimmer will be limited to 4 individual events and 1 relay. If an entry is submitted with a swimmer in more individual events than allowed, the swimmer will be entered into the order of events until the rule is satisfied. Absolutely no deck entries will be allowed.

Entry Format: **Hy-Tek Team Manager meet entry files must be sent by email.** A confirmation entry list will be emailed back to the person who sent the email entry.

The following must be received prior to the start of warm-ups:

- Team summary report and executed release, and hold harmless agreement (included in this packet)
- Check for payment of all entry fees made out to Zionsville Swim Club.

Entry Deadlines: Entries will be accepted starting November 14, 2022. Entry deadline will be November 21, 2022.

Fees: \$5.00 per individual event. Make checks payable to Zionsville Swim Club. Please bring a check to be paid before start of the meet. No deck entries will be allowed. There will be no refunds issued for any missed or scratched events.

There will be a \$10 surcharge per athlete to cover Indiana Swimming charges and admission fees.

Officials: All USA Swimming certified officials are welcomed and encouraged to officiate. Please provide the names of any officials interested in participating, along with day(s) and session(s) available, and a contact phone number.

Awards: Ribbons will be given for 1st through 8th place in individual events.

Awards will be mailed to host clubs post event.

RULES, POLICIES, AND RISK ASSUMPTION

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of December 4, 2021 shall determine the swimmer’s age for the entire meet. Indiana Swimming does not process onsite memberships.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer’s responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

The competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming Rule 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made of textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Coaches and Officials MUST display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The meet referee and/or meet director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no longer valid/current.

The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in any changing area, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Deck changes are prohibited. It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

COVID Risk Assumption

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and individuals with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

USA Swimming, Inc., cannot prevent you (or your child(ren)) from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19 while participating in USA Swimming sanctioned events. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to participate in a USA Swimming sanctioned event, you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19.

By attending or participating in this competition, you voluntarily assume all risks associated with exposure to covid-19 and forever release and hold harmless usa swimming and indiana swimming and each of their officers, directors, agents, employees or other representatives from any liability or claims including for personal injuries, death, disease or property losses, or any other loss, including but not limited to claims of negligence and give up any

Claims you may have to seek damages, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, in connection with exposure, infection, and/or spread of covid-19 related to participation in this competition.

Safe Sport 360

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

§ Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. § All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. This includes participation as a member of a relay.
