The Fall Classic (tentatively set Oct. 20-21st) will be the same format and Aquasprints (tentatively set for Feb. 8-10) will move to a Prelims/Final venue. After the HUGE success of Aquasprints we are anticipating both meets to continue to grow.

After the huge success of Aquasprints we were left wondering how could we make it any better. After discussing with other teams what they would like to see us do with Aquasprints the dominate response was to offer a prelims/finals format. The Board and our Coaches have discussed and agreed to make the 2013 Aquasprints a Prelims/Finals format.
