

THE WOLFPACK IS BACK with a COVID SAFETY PLAN! (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Program and Facility Safety Requirements:

- Entrance to facility
 - Entry off Morgan via the gate into the alley
 - **NO ENTRY OFF ROOSEVELT RD!**
 - Parents should park prior to dropping off if walking swimmers to the door.
 - Cars will not be allowed to idle or park in the alley drive during class time.
 - Walk up the grass lawn to the exterior back door of the small pool (follow the cones)
 - Check-in stations will be set up at the entrance.
 - **Check in begins at 6:30 PM, Class begins at 6:40 PM**
- Limited Numbers:
 - Max of 34 swimmers per weeknight session
 - **No wait list spots offered**, to be placed on a wait list please email Coach Sam at wolfpackswimlessons@gmail.com
- Deck Limitations
 - Max number of 42 bodies on deck (swimmers + instructors + supervisor)
 - No parents/guardians are allowed in the facility per UIC policy.
 - Pending nice weather parents may be seated in chairs outside the facility on the patio.
 - Looking into the option to live stream/ zoom call the lesson class so parents still can watch class.
- Temperature checks and symptoms screening required per facility protocol:
 - Symptom screening should be done prior to coming to the facility.
 - Sneezing, coughing, fever, running nose, sore throat, headache, upset stomach, etc. – Do not come to the pool, no exceptions.
 - **When in doubt, always err on the side of caution.**
 - Temperature screenings prior to entering the facility.
 - Temperature greater than 100 F via digital reading will not be allowed to enter the facility.
 - If a parent is walking a swimmer to the pool door and remaining in the waiting area, temperature screening is required of them as well.
- Masking Requirements
 - Swimmers: required masking prior to entering the facility, while waiting for class to start, and immediately following exiting the pool at end of class.
 - Instructors and supervisor:
 - In water instructors will wear a face shield and maintain distance as much as effective instruction allows for, removing for in water demonstrations.
 - On deck instructors will wear face shield for the entire class period
- Maintaining distance is necessary.
 - Swimmers should be seated in their level's designated area.
 - They will be escorted by their level instructor from the designated area to their assigned lane.
 - Alternating points of entry will allow for spacing of different levels.
- Limited access to changing space:
 - 1 on deck washroom
 - Parents plan on **swimmers coming to the pool in their suits, ready to swim, and leaving in their swimsuits following class** at least for now.
 - On deck with swimmer lesson essentials only– towel, goggles, cap, deck shoes, clothes for after. Avoid packing large swim bags.
 - Swimmers will not be able to borrow goggles or swim caps.
