FACILITY: 10 lane 25-yard competition pool with non-turbulent lane markers + 5 lanes for cool down. Starting end: 14 foot depth, turn end: 7 foot depth. Kiefer Elite starting blocks with fins are located at the deep end of the pool (14 foot depth). Colorado System 6 timing system with non-slip touch pads, one backup button, and a 10 lane digital scoreboard in color will be used. Seating capacity for 650 spectators is available. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

FORMAT: Timed Final Pre-Seeded Meet

Warmups at 1:00pm, Meet Starts 2:00pm

ENTRY

DEADLINE: This is a closed meet, all entries are due Monday, June 20th.
Additional entries or scratches will be accepted until Tuesday June 28th.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter up to 4 individual events.

ENTRY

FEES: The entry fee is \$5.00 for each individual event. A surcharge of \$15 per swimmer covers ISI surcharge & facility fees.
Make all checks out to **HP Aquatics Club**, with one check per club.

AWARDS: All 12&Under Events receive ribbons 1st thru 8th place.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmer's age as of the start of the meet will determine his or her age for the entire meet. USA Swimming registered athletes and FINA registered athletes are eligible. All swimmers must be registered prior to competing. Entries listed as "Registration applied for" will not be accepted. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RULES & SAFETY: All current USA Swimming and ISI Rules and Regulations apply. All ISI and USA Swimming safety rules will be strictly enforced. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. USA SWIMMING MEMBERSHIP: Insurance regulations require that all swimmers, coaches, judges, starters, and referees be a current member of USA Swimming, Inc. It is each club's responsibility to register their swimmers, coaches, and officials. Swimmers, coaches, and officials who are not current members of USA Swimming, Inc. may not participate in the meet nor be on the pool deck. Be sure to display your credentials in order to gain access to the pool deck.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES: In accordance with USA Swimming Rules, Articles 105 and 202.1.13, the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. It is the responsibility of the coaches or swimmers to contact the Meet Referee with specific requests.

DRONES: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

MAAPP: All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
