Location: Hinsdale Community Pool, 500 W. Hinsdale Avenue, Hinsdale, IL 60521. (630) 789-7098

Facility: 8 lane, 50-meter competition pool. It is equipped with non-turbulent lane lines, permanent starting blocks, a horn start system with a strobe and automatic timing with touch pads. Seating capacity is 500. Starting depth at the east end of the pool is 5'0" and depth at the turn end is 3'6". There is also a diving well within the pool grounds and it can be used only for warm-ups and cool-downs (no diving is permitted, feet-first entry only and all other warm-up and safety procedures to be followed as described at the end of this meet packet). The facility is owned and operated by the Village of Hinsdale. As necessary, staff at the facility will handle operational matters (pool cleanliness, storm closures, etc.). Please note that the Host Club does not control operational decisions.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2C(4) of the 2015 USA Swimming Rulebook

Outdoor Meet: Please address swimmer precautions at an outdoor meet. Sun screen, plenty of fluids, as well as the proper goggles for eye protection. In the event of severe weather, we will follow the direction of pool staff. Staff will likely follow local guidelines or those of the National Lightning and Safety Institute to clear the pool and pool area in the event of thunder or lightning or another weather issue. The Host Club will do its best to resume the meet and continue events once the closure ceases.

Recording Devices and Swimmer Privacy: Use of audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Cell phones, video and camera devices are not permitted behind the blocks or above swimmers as they enter or depart the pool. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Any individual failing to abide by the above may be subject to immediate removal from the venue by Meet

Management and could be subject to the USA Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Articles 304, 305 or 306.

Drones: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Parking: Parking is available at the pool but is limited. Additional parking is available on the north side of Hinsdale Avenue and public streets south of the pool. Please caution your parents that the Village of Hinsdale strictly enforces its posted parking restrictions.

Admissions:

All sessions: no charge for members of the military with a valid Military ID or in uniform; no charge for children 12 years of age and younger

Friday session: \$7 for adults and teens, \$5 for senior citizens

Saturday, each session: \$7 for adults and teens, \$5 for senior citizens

Sunday, each session: \$7 for adults and teens, \$5 for senior citizens

Weekend rates: \$20 for Friday/Saturday/Sunday; senior citizens may purchase a weekend wristband for \$12

Heat Sheets: We are “going green” for this meet. Printed heat sheets will NOT be available at the meet. The meet, including heat sheets, will be available online *at no charge* through the Meet Mobile app and Live Results. Heat sheets will be posted for swimmers at several places on deck and available to coaches at the Admin table. Coaches are responsible for distributing their copies of the heat sheets to responsible individuals who will assist their swimmers in determining when they are swimming.

Warm-ups: Warm-up lane assignments will be determined after entries have closed

Results: Results will be available at <http://hinsdaleswimming.org> at the conclusion of the meet and will be made available utilizing the Meet Mobile app.

Timers: All entered teams may be asked to provide timers. The Schedule of Timers will be based on team entry size and this schedule will be made available to each participating team shortly after entries are closed.

NOTE: THIS MEET WILL REQUIRE POSITIVE CHECK-IN

Positive Check-In: All swimmers must check-in prior to each session. Check-in station will be located at the west end of the pool. Check-in will close for each session 20 minutes after the scheduled start of warm-ups for that session (regardless of when warm-ups actually start). All swimmers who do not check-in for a session will be scratched for that session. Swimmers must physically present themselves at the check-in station to be checked-in. Deck entries will not be permitted.

NOTE: There will be a separate check-in for the 400M Freestyle (Events 11 and 12 in Session 1), 800M Freestyle (Events 21 and 22 in Session 2), 400M Freestyle (Events 51 and 52 in Session 4), and 400M IM (Events 79 and 80 in Session 6). Listen to the announcer for details!

Eligibility: Only USA Swimming and FINA registered swimmers are eligible. Entries listed “Registration Applied For” will not be accepted. All swimmers must be registered prior to the entry deadline. USA registration forms can be obtained from Illinois Swimming, Inc.; 1400 East Touhy Ave. Suite 410, Des Plaines, IL 60018 (847) 824-1596, FAX (847) 824-1726 or ilswimoffice@sbcglobal.net. In all events swimmers must swim in their own age group (senior events are not age group). Age for this meet shall be the swimmer’s age as of June 28th, 2019. Relay swimmers must be entered in at least one individual event.

Relay Starts: The 2nd and 4th swimmers in the 200M Relays will start in the water. (3.5 ft. depth)

Rules & Safety: 2019 USA Swimming Inc. and ISI rules will govern the meet. All USA Swimming and ISI Swimming rules and the ISI individual scratch rule will be strictly enforced. All USA Swimming and Illinois swimming safety rules will be enforced. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Coaches: All coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming and must provide proof of current registration at all sessions of this meet. Coaches must continuously display their current USA Swimming coaching membership cards or the HSC-provided lanyard at all times while on deck. All coaches are required to sign in if they are on deck or if they are off deck and engaging with swimmers.

Seeding: All events will be pre-seeded after the close of positive check-in. Each event will be swum in heats with swimmers seeded from slowest to fastest, except the 800M Freestyle which will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating women's and men's heats. Swimmers must provide their own counter and timer for the 800M Freestyle.

Long Event Entry Limit: We reserve the right to limit heats for all individual events 200M or longer. We also reserve the right to cut relays to meet timeline rules.

E-mail Entries & Forms: Only e-mail entries will be accepted and the following guidelines must be followed:

- 1.) Official entry form, all entry fees and swimmer surcharges are due within 72 hours following entry acceptance.
- 2.) E-mail entries must be in the form of a Hy-Tek Meet Manager generated format. You must "zip" the file so that it arrives to the entry chair intact to the following e-mail: headcoachscott@hinsdaleswimming.org. Hinsdale Swim Club will use Hy-Tek Meet Manager 7.0 software to run the meet.
- 3.) Your club's entire entry must be sent in one e-mail. Please do not send multiple e-mails which compose one single team entry. The host club accepts no responsibility for receipt or quality of the transmission.
- 4.) All entries must be submitted in long-course meter (LCM) times.
- 5.) The enclosed Summary of Fees Statement must be completed and the Release Form signed. These must be returned together with the entry forms and your check to the Meet Entry Chair. Failure to do so shall be sufficient grounds for refusal of the entry.

Swimmer's USA Swimming Numbers/Age: All swimmers USA Swimming registration numbers must be included on the entry forms. ISI swimmers list only the last nine digits. If not registered with ISI, list all twelve digits. Swimmer's age must be shown in the column indicated. Failure to comply with entry requirements is sufficient cause to reject entries.

Entries: Swimmers are limited to swim three individual events per session, not counting relays. There will be no refunds for scratched events, declared false starts or no shows. Incoming entries will be entered on a first come/first served bases. An entry which was submitted properly and prior to the Meet Entry deadline, but which was left out the Meet Program will be considered an Official Entry to the meet. The Meet Referee may take action necessary to include such omitted swimmers in the proper events at the meet. This may range from adding a swimmer to an early heat in an event to reseeding.

Relays: The host club reserves the right to cancel any/all relay events listed in order to ensure completion of the session for swimmers twelve (12) and under within a 4-hour time frame (ISI, Article 203.3.1). Any entries that are canceled by the host club will be refunded.

Entry Fees: Individual events are \$5.00 each. Relays are \$10.00 per event. In addition, the host club will collect a surcharge of \$2.00 per swimmer (for ISI) and a facility charge of \$8.00 per swimmer. Please make checks payable to HINSDALE SWIM CLUB. If events other than relays are cancelled (see relay policy), the Host Club may consider partial refund of swimmer fees only if it does not have to pay the facility fee or the ISI charge. If the Host Team cancels an event due to circumstances within the Host Team's control, the event fee will be refunded. Like all teams, the Host Club will abide by ISI policy but there will be no refunds except as provided above or in ISI policy.

Entry Deadline: Entries will not be accepted before **9:00 am, Friday, June 7th, 2019**. Entry submitter will be notified via e-mail within 48 hours of admission to the meet. Entries shall not be considered finalized until entry form and payment is delivered to entry chairperson which as stated above shall be within 72 hours of notification of acceptance. **Updated seed times will be accepted until 12:00pm (noon), Friday, June 21st, 2019.** Admissions/deletions may be accepted at the discretion of the Entry Chair also through June 21st, 2019. Deck entries will not be accepted. In the event of unusual or extenuating circumstances, the Meet Director reserves the discretion to accept late entries until the final program is printed or posted. Late entries will not be accepted 48 hours after the deadline.

Awards: Awards will be given for the top eight individual finishers of each individual event and the top three finishers in each of the relay events in 12 and under events. There will be no individual event or relay awards for 13 and overs. There will be no individual high point trophies or team trophies awarded. Coaches are to pick up awards at the end of the meet prior to receiving their final results.

Results: Preliminary results will be posted as available on Meet Mobile. Coaches are to handle any disputes by talking to the Meet Referee.

Concessions: A snack shop is available inside pool grounds. Hospitality and meals will be provided to coaches and officials at the west end of the pool near the pool house.

Warm-Up Procedures (To Be Posted)

A. WARM-UP PROCEDURES

1. General Warm-up

- a. There will be assigned warm-up lanes for this meet.
- b. Entry into pool from starting end of pool only, unless noted otherwise by the Meet Director and Meet Referee.
- c. No diving shall be allowed from the blocks or the edge of the pool at any time when a lane is being used for any one swimmers to swim more than one length. At such times, swimmers must enter the pool feet first, while maintaining contact with the deck with the body and a hand from the start end of the pool.
- d. When a coach converts the use of a lane to a diving lane, swimmers shall swim one length from the start end and exit the pool at the turn end. No swimmer shall return to the start end or linger in swimming to the turn end to exit the pool.

B. SAFETY GUIDELINES

1. Coaches Responsibilities

- a. Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practices.
- b. Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the Warm-up session at meets and all practices.

2. Host Team Responsibilities

- a. Marshaling
 - 1) A minimum of two (2) marshals, who report to and receive instructions from the Meet Referee, shall be on the deck during the warm-up session.
 - 2) Marshals shall be current members of USA Swimming.
 - 3) Marshals shall have the authority to remove from the deck, for the remainder of the warm-up session, any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety or warm-up procedures.
- b. The host team shall provide signs for each lane at both ends of the pool, which indicate the designated use during warm-up.
- c. Warm-up times and lane assignments shall be published in the meet information and posted at several locations around the pool area. The following statement shall appear in the information: "Illinois Swimming, Inc. Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in affect at this meet."
- d. An announcer shall be on duty (using a public address system only after 8:00am) for each Warm-up session to announce lane and/or time changes and to assist with the conduct of the Warm-up. The announcer will utilize the public address system only for emergencies during any part of a Warm-Up session prior to 8:00am. Officials and team volunteers will assist with the coordination of Warm-Up sessions prior to 8:00am. We cannot use the public address system prior to 8:00am each day. Coaches are encouraged to plan for Warm-ups in advance.
- e. Hazards in locker rooms, on the deck area or in areas used by coaches, swimmers, spectators, or officials shall be removed or clearly marked.

3. Miscellaneous:

- a. Backstrokers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks.
- b. Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
- c. Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during the warm-up session.

- d. Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks scheduled during the competition.
- e. The Referee may restrict use of bands, hand paddles, or fins during warm-up. The Referee shall have control over mitigation actions necessary to relieve situations deemed as dangerous or impairing the safety of other swimmers.

Note: The host club may, the consent of the Meet Director and Meet Referee, modify the warm-up time schedule or recommend lane assignments depending on pool configuration, number of swimmers or other consideration, so long as safety considerations are not compromised. Any such changes shall be announced, and/or posted prominently in the pool area.
