**Location:** RecPlex Aqua Arena, 9900 Terwall Terrace, Pleasant Prairie WI 53158

**Facility:** Indoor, 10 la25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane lines. Pool depth 7' at the shallow end and 12' feet at the deep end. Starting blocks are 29.5". The competition course has been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Rule 104.2.2C(4).

**Timing System:** Fully automated Colorado timing system.

\*Approximate times: warm-ups will begin immediately after the conclusion of the morning session, but not before 12:30pm. All events are Positive Check In. Check In will close 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups. The meet will begin 1 hour after the start of warm-ups.

**Eligibility:** All swimmers must be current (2019) members of USA Swimming. USA swimming deck registrations will not be accepted. A swimmer's age for the meet will be his/her age as of October 16, 2021.

**Disabled Athletes:** Please notify the meet director and meet referee for any special requirements of athletes prior to the start of the first session.

**Coaches:** Coaches must be current members of USA Swimming to be allowed on deck and must

display their current registration card at all times.

## **COVID-19**

In applying for this sanction (ed event), the Host, Mundelein Mustang Swim Club agrees to comply and to enforce all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Wisconsin Swimming, Inc., the State of Wisconsin, and the Kenosha County Health Department.

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures – for you, the other participants, and meet staff. You must follow all instructions while visiting the Pleasant Prairie Rec-Plex. ### **MAAPP Policy:**

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. An athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered “not in good standing” and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

### **COVID-19 Safety Plan**

#### **According to Rule**

**202.4.16:** This plan is for a sanctioned swim meet using semi-automatic timing competing in 10 of the 20 available competition lanes and manual back-up timing using 10 of the 20 available competition lanes. The competition pool is a 2x10 lane 25-yard indoor pool.

**Pool Capacity:** Current municipal limit is 50% Capacity per session (the meet is capped at 350 swimmers/session). If the projected number of participants is close to this number, entries will stop being accepted. There is ample deck space to maintain 6-foot distancing with a few exceptions noted below. Face masks are optional.

**Health Monitoring:** It is expected that all swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers are COVID symptom free and without known exposure with someone with COVID symptoms or diagnosis within the last 10 days. All swimmers, coaches and volunteers entering the facility will be screened. All persons admitted to the pool deck will have their temperature checked before entering the facility. Anyone over 100.4 degrees may not enter the facility.

**MASK Mandate:** at the time of publishing of the meet announcement, there is currently no mask mandate or requirement at the facility. If that changes, a notice to all attending teams will be sent and adherence to any, and all, mandates is required from participating teams.

**Entry and Exit:** Athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers will enter the pool through the Aqua Arena entrance of the Rec Plex. Swimmers will then travel onto the deck by walking through the locker rooms. Coaches, officials and volunteers must check in at the table in front of the Aqua Desk with credentials and/or volunteer confirmation. They will then enter the pool deck through the Shark Room. A meet marshal shall be placed at the Aqua Desk to ensure that only athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers are allowed past the Aqua Desk.

**Locker rooms:** Locker rooms will be available for swimmers to use, but marshals will ensure that no swimmers are using the locker rooms as a crash area. Showers and changing are not allowed at this time. Swim bags shall be placed in the designated swimmer rest areas. Bathrooms will be cleaned regularly per RecPlex facilities safety plan.

**Spectators:** Spectators will be allowed inside the facility. The meet will be live streamed and those wishing to watch are encouraged to do so in a socially distant manner.

**Warm-up:** A meet marshal will be assigned to manage the warm-up lanes. Swimmers may be limited to the amount of warm-up/down time at the discretion of the meet referee. Warm up lanes and times will be assigned and sent out prior to the start of the session.

**Deck set-up:** Deck marking and signage will be posted throughout the facility to help attendees maintain 6-foot spacing throughout the meet. Hand sanitizing stations will be available upon entry and on the deck. Disposable face masks (for \$1) will be available at the RecPlex front desk. Teams are encouraged to provide masks to swimmers who come unprepared.

**Volunteers and Officials:** The following workers would be inside the facility. All officials, coaches, and volunteers will wear masks and must sign the waivers.

- Deck Officials: Stationed per the meet referee's instruction. Wisconsin Officials Rules will be followed. Mask required.
- 1 Administrative Official: Stationed in the Shark Room. Mask required.
- 1-2 Runners: Delivering timer sheets and DQ notification to the AO and computer operator. Mask required.
- 10 Back-Up Lane Timers: 1 timer per lane. When on starting end (100s and up) timers will be placed a minimum of 6-feet behind the lane for the start of each race and move to pool edge after the racing swimmer has entered the pool to race and

on the last 50-yard swim before the finish. When the race ends, timers will move back to the mark that is a minimum of 6-feet behind the lane to allow the swimmer in the next heat to walk up behind the blocks. Mask required.

- Chief timers: Positioned behind finishing end. Start watch on every race to provide back-up if needed. Mask required.
- Up to 5 Clerk of Course Workers: Number depends on size of meet and age of competitors. Duties are to direct swimmers to marks in clerk of course line and signal swimmers to move to the next mark when appropriate. Mask required.
- Up to 8 Meet Marshals: Number depends on size of meet and age of participants. Duties are to enforce social distancing during warm-up and throughout the meet and monitor entry to the facility. Mask required.
- 1-2 Event Video Operators: Stationed in the Aquatic mezzanine, manages display of current event number and heat that is being broadcast out for the meet to be seen live. Mask required.
- 1 Announcer: Stationed in the Shark Room or Aqua Mezzanine. Additional duty to help encourage and promote social distancing. Mask required.
- 1 Timing system Operator: Stationed in the Aqua Mezzanine with view of the finishing end. Mask required.
- 1-2 Computer Operator: Stationed in the Aqua Mezzanine if needed or in the Shark Room with a view of finishing end in direct communication with the timing system operator. Mask required.
- 1 Meet Technical Specialist: Ensures continued proper operation of timing system, computer system and other equipment throughout the meet. Mask required.

<b>Meet Rules:</b>	<p>All USA Swimming Inc. and WI LSC rules apply, including safety rules which will be strictly enforced. Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. Feet first three*point entries from the starting end of the pool during general warm-ups will be enforced for all sanctioned/approved competition in accordance with the recent change to policy 4.5.2(a). Teams will be assigned warm up lanes to use as they wish. Violators of the Wisconsin Swimming warm up procedure are subject to disqualification.</p> <p>In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc. shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.</p>
<b>Seeding:</b>	<p>All events will be Positive Check in, timed finals. Swimmers not checked in prior to the check in deadline will be scratched from that session. For seeding purposes please submit Short Course Yard times. NT's are acceptable. Special seeding procedures will be used for disability athletes. (see USA Rule 202.2.13)</p>
<b>Conduct:</b>	<p>All clubs will be responsible for their own swimmers. Any swimmer entered into the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004-the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.</p> <p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.</p>
<b>Deck Changes:</b>	<p><i>Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other</i></p>

	<i>than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.</i>

<b>Entries:</b>	Entries will be accepted by the entry chair starting at 8:00 am Friday, September 17th 2021. Entries will only be accepted via email. Entries will be accepted until the meet is full. Teams must submit hard copies, waivers and payment within 72hrs of meet acceptance.  <b>Send forms, waiver and payment to:</b> MMSC, PO Box 1017, Mundelein IL 60060
<b>Entry Fees:</b>	Individual events are \$6.00 each. A surcharge of \$4.00 per swimmer entered in individual events must be included with your entry. \$5.00 per swimmer facility fee also will apply. There will be a \$16.00 admission charge applied to all athletes entered in the meet. <b>Please make checks payable to Mundelein Mustang Swim Club.</b>
<b>Entry Limit:</b>	Swimmers may enter Five (5) individual events per day. Events of 200y or longer maybe limited.
<b>Deck Entries:</b>	Deck entries will be accepted to fill open lanes. Cost will be \$10.00 per event plus the \$4.00 Wisconsin Swimming surcharge if the swimmer isn’t already entered into the meet.
<b>Awards:</b>	Ribbons for 1-12th place in all individual events for 8 and Under, 9-10 and 11-12. Swimmers in the Open category will not receive awards.
<b>Admissions:</b>	No admission will be charged for spectators. The meet fees include an admission surcharge of \$16.00 per swimmer. Heat Sheets for each session will be included in the admission fee. Meet mobile heat sheets will also be included.
<b>Concessions:</b>	Food and drink will be available from the Rec Plex concession stand during the meet. No glass containers are permitted on deck.
<b>Vendors:</b>	Elsmore will be on site Saturday and Sunday.
<b>Meet Results:</b>	A copy of the final results will be provided to each participating team via email and posted on both the MMSC and WI Swimming websites.

<b>Timers:</b>	MMSC will do our best to cover as many lanes as possible. However, some assistance with timing may be needed. If this occurs teams will be notified the Monday before the meet of timing needs.
<b>Officials:</b>	There will be a need for officials to help the meet run smoothly. Certified officials should contact Steve Fidanze, <a href="mailto:SFidanze@yahoo.com">SFidanze@yahoo.com</a> . Any assistance that can be provided would greatly be appreciated.
<b>Parking:</b>	There is plenty of free parking available
<b>Competition Waiver:</b>	All participants (swimmers, coaches and officials) will be required to complete the “Competition Waiver”, which will be sent out to attending teams once meet entries have been closed or the meet is full.
