Meet Summary

On Friday afternoon, the SCA swim team started what would be a truly successful meet with the 1500 freestyle session where the swimmers proved that SCA distance swimming is alive and well! After this session, we were in first place for the team scores! As the night went on, many swimmers conquered the IM events, including the longest IM, the 400. Ripley Merritt, Luca McGee, Lilly Heine, and Sydney Koehn all placed top 8 in the 15 and over 400 IM, all with personal best times. As a testament to her training, Lilly Heine was able to compete well after just finishing the mile earlier that day when she dropped over two minutes! Moving onto Saturday, 11 and over swimmers had to balance both prelims and finals, while 10 and under swimmers swam timed finals in the middle session. In that middle session, Rohen Sievers, Reece Merritt, Blake Waldo, and Mason Poswinski all competed in the 50 meter freestyle and all were able to go lifetime best times. This was a great way to start the session off strong! Ella Rischling also shined in the 10 and under session, finishing in 1st in the 100 fly, and going her lifetime

best time by over two seconds! In prelims for the 11 and overs, Maggie Steward really put on a show for the crowd of yes that's right, spectators when she dropped over 7 seconds in prelims. She was seeded 25th overall, but moved all the way up to 8th earning herself a place in the top heat for finals where she dropped another two seconds, moving from 8th to 6th overall. In the 13 and 14 boys 200 meter butterfly, 4 out of the top 8 swimmers were from the SCA swim team! Everett Loney, Logan Poswinski, Noah Van Zuidam, and Bernie Leal Sierra all powered through during this challenging event. The 10 and unders finished the Sunday session strong! At the conclusion of this great session, Lyla Rischling, Ella Rischling, and Rohen Sievers all received a high point award for being in the top three of their age groups. The older kids also had a great day on Sunday. One must see race was the 11 and 12 girls 50 breaststroke. SCA had 5 swimmers in the top 16! Bailey Forsyth, Ellie Coyne, Maddi Cribbs, Bria Leffers, and Lilah Van Zuidam all represented the Summit City swim team in finals. The final event of the night was the 100 meter freestyle and SCA did not disappoint. Hayden Lynam led us to victory by placing 1st in the 13 and 14 boys race and dropping over 2 seconds from his preliminary swim. Next up was the 15 and over girls, where we had 6 swimmers out of the top 16 with Maggie Stock taking second. The last race was 15 and over boys where 4 SCA swimmers swam in the top 16. Owen Lindsay finished strong into the wall, earning himself a first place finish! It was a great team effort as we finished 3rd overall and

were the top team from Indiana. SCA proved this weekend that we can be strong in both the distance and sprinting events.
