

The Vigo County Schools Aquatic Center leases the pool for practice, lessons and competition. The following is a description of locker room use at the aquatic center.

As part of USA Swimming's Safe Sport Program, the changing and locker area are designated for swimmers. The purpose is to prevent any misconduct in locker and changing areas. Please have all swimmers store bags and clothes in the brown day lockers during practice/swim lessons or bring their things out onto the pool deck bleachers. The blue, green, and red lockers and changing areas are for high school swimmers only. THT has limited use of locker facilities for practice and swim lessons. The Torpedoes program has staggered practice and swim lesson start times. We discourage parents from entering the locker area but will provide a 10-minute window from 6:30-6:40 and 7-7:10 for parents to assist swimmers under 8 to change clothes. Other THT groups immediately follow these windows. Please change swimmers as quickly as possible. It may be necessary to attend practice/swim lessons dressed for swimming and then shower at home. Checking on or assisting a swimmer should be a same-sex parent. Swimmers of the opposite gender should not enter the locker room of the other (girl's in boy's locker area and vice versa). The lobby restrooms are off-limits to athletes for changing purposes. This creates an unsafe atmosphere for other pool visitors. The aquatic center staff will make occasional sweeps to assist if necessary, but locker room supervision of athletes is the responsibility of the coaches. Every effort will be made to check on athletes who do not return from the locker room in a timely fashion. Please make the best use of the space available. In an emergency do not hesitate to enter the locker room and immediately contact an aquatic center staff member or coach for assistance. Cell phones and other electronic recording devices are strictly prohibited in the locker rooms.
