**The LAB meet is not to qualify for the state meet. It is for swimmers with NO state times for their end of the season Champs-- it is like a B Championships. The 8 and under meet is for any 8 and under swimmer to have their 8 and under Champs! The 8 and under swimmer will swim in the 13 and over session on Saturday afternoon.

CONDITION OF SANCTION

SWIMMER Guidelines

We will swim a 25 easy at the completion of each race and swimmers will get out on the opposite side of the pool.

Facilities: Indoor, 25 yard, eight lane pool with Kiefer non-turbulent lane ropes
Water Depth: Starting at 4 ft going to 6 ft
The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Timing: Colorado 5000 system with Infinity Starter, with one button, touchpads, and stopwatch backups.

Rules: Conduct of this sanctioned event shall conform in every respect to all technical and administrative rules of USA Swimming and Louisiana Swimming.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee shall assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure the compliance with this requirement.

All meet directors, referees, starters, and stroke and turn judges, serving in an official capacity must be members of USA Swimming.

All coaches and officials MUST constantly display their current USA Swimming credential or be prepared to present their USA Swimming ID card

as proof of their registration to the Meet Director or designee at any time. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if the coach does not comply or his/her card is no longer valid/current.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

MAAPP:

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Safe Sport:

The LSI Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet who is unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer’s team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a

drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials, and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.

Eligibility: No entrant will be permitted to compete unless the entrant is a member of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302.

Limit of Events: 9 and Over Swimmers Swimmers will be limited to swimming three events per day. 9 and over swimmers cannot enter this meet if they have a state time!!!! 8 and under swimmers can enter 4 events during the Saturday afternoon 8 and under session.

Entries: All entries must be sent to colaswim@yahoo.com by Friday, March 12th so we can determine sessions.

Entry Fees: *Individual events: \$3.50 each
*Swimmer Surcharge: \$15.00 per swimmer
*\$8 of this is LASwimming Surcharge and \$7 is a facility fee.
*Relays: \$8.00 per relay

Awards: Swimmers finishing 1st-8th in each event place will receive awards.

Format: All events will be swum as listed below, but will be scored and heated in age groups: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15-18.

IMAGE RELEASE

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the host club approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the host club or LSI website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.
