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RECORDS AND TOP TIMES

I. General

- A. Iowa Swimming is responsible for recording and maintaining:
1. Iowa Records – Swum by ISI registered athletes anywhere in the world.
 2. Iowa Open Records – Swum in Iowa by any USA Swimming registered athlete.
 3. Iowa Swimming Team Manager Times Database.
 4. USA Swimming – Iowa Swimming Portal.
- B. Iowa Records must be obtained under the conditions stated in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Book.
1. Records can be made only in still water.
 2. Official time for records must be achieved and determined in accordance with 102.24.
 3. Iowa Records must be achieved by ISI member swimmers in USA Swimming or FINA sanctioned competition. This competition can be at any level including Senior and International Competition.
 4. Iowa Records achieved by member swimmers in approved competition or in USA Swimming observed swims will be recognized.
 5. Record times registered by automatic equipment shall be submitted in hundredths of a second (two decimal places). Records in which times are tied to the 100th seconds shall be declared a tie and shared by the athletes involved.
 6. No record shall be considered which is applied for by or through a conference, league, LSC, allied member, or organizational member whose rules governing performance do not conform to Parts One, Two and Seven of USA Swimming rules and Regulations unless such swim is OBSERVED in accordance with 202.7
 7. Record attempts at an initial distance for an individual event or the lead-off leg of a relay may be used if the athlete completes the event. An official split time is
 8. recorded from the automatic timing system or from the 3 official timers assigned to that lane using digital watches. (Split request slips can obtained from meet host).

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9. Should the first swimmer on a relay team complete his/her leg in a record time for that stroke/distance, his/her performance shall not be nullified by any disqualification of his/her team members. (Be sure to notify meet management & complete Split Request form, so time can be recorded)
10. Conversion between yards and meters is NOT allowed.
10. Times from swims in senior events will be moved to the appropriate age group - 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, or 17-18.

IV. Eligible Athletes

All Iowa Swimming, Inc. registered swimmers.

V. Eligible Times

All verified times swum in USA/ISI Sanctioned meets as well as Approved or Observed meets.

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VI. Procedures

A. Record Applications

1. **ISI Meets:** The Iowa Swimming will enter meet results into the ISI Team Manager database and run a record match for each meet.
2. **USA Swimming Sanctioned, Approved or Observed Meets Outside of Iowa:** The swimmer must complete and forward the Official ISI Time Reporting Form (APP-16) to ISI no later than one (1) week after receipt of the final results or Meet Manager Results file with cover email stating meet name, location, date and sanction number.
3. **High School District and State Championship meets** will be an observed meet by ISI officials. Times for high school athletes (if currently registered) will be entered into the ISI database and considered for records.

VII. Changes From the Sanctioned Meet Announcement

Require notification to the Records Chair to determine validity of the results.

VIII. Deadlines For Reporting Times

ISI Times are to be submitted no later than one week after ISI Spring Championships or Spring National meets.
