- GARDNER - Only Outdoor Meet, pond. Many NY & Canada teams. Timed Finals.
- SENIORS - At Brown. Trials & Finals. All New England swimmers.

1:07.3 4 (sixth-place time, followed by (4) number of New England swimmers who placed in top six swimmers)

EDITORIAL:

In the Region I's, there were 258 swims that exceeded the cut-off time. In the 100-Free, 17 girls and 33 boys were unable to meet the standard; in the 200-Free, 18 girls and 25 boys did not do so. Following close behind were the 200 I. M. and the 100 Breast and 100 Back.

Surprisingly, almost everybody made the cut-offs in the very difficult swims: the 400 I.M., the 200-Fly and the 400-Free.

It would seem that swimmers have a much harder time in the shorter swims -- or should the Swim Committee caution swimmers and coaches against anticipating a swimmer's achievement?

Despite this poor attendance, Coralie O'Connor (WSC) was elected to attend the National Convention, where all national rules are set.

Note: Every swim club is allowed a delegate to this meeting. To send a delegate, club must request proper application form from NEAAU Chairman Frank Rull, NEAAU Office, 69 Canal Street, Boston. It should be done NOW.

Sanction: Get application from Jack Hayden, 59 Sculpin Way, Swampscott, Mass. Fill out and return with copy of meet 45 days prior to meet.

"Invitation": After approval from Mark & Jack, send entry blank to every club 30 days prior to meet. Entry closing date must be 10 days before actual meet.

Results: Results must be sent the following:

 1 to Jack Hayden (address above)
 1 to Mark Michelson (address above)
 1 to Frank Rull, 69 Canal Street, Boston, Mass.
 1 to Joe Drolette, 59 S. Douglas, Rockland, Mass.

- REQUIREMENTS:
- A host-team must provide referee, starter, 2 stroke & turn judges, 1 head-timer for each lane. All these must be certified.

 - With Results, send Evaluation Sheet to clubs participating (get these from Mark Michelson).
 - Time Standards must be used to designate meet type.

Dick Close, National Swimming Officials Chairman, conducted a special seminar for about 20 NEAAU swim officials last weekend at the Executive Conference Room of the Peoples Bank in Worcester. Regarding swimmer disqualifications, Close said, "The national concensus of officiating techniques on rule interpretation should protect those who follow the rules, rather than force the LETTER of the rule on swimmers. It is the INTENT of the rule, rather than the LETTER that matters." Following a lengthy question-and-answer session, some of the seminar participants took the exam for National qualification.

Close also said that a "Meet Managers Manual" is in the works -- an outline or check-list "What to Do" format that should help standardize swim meets.

Coralie O'Connor brought back results of the National Rules Committee. N-P hopes to print some of these next month. In the meantime, look forward to the mile swim being run in alternate mens-womens heats, relay times deck-proven prior to seeding, and 15-17 Age Group changing to 15-18.

It was also learned that the 1975 A-B-C Standard Times are SLOWER than the 1974.

LONG-COURSE OUTSTANDING SWIMMERS
