

EXECUTIVE BOARD NEWS

Because of changes and additions to board positions, the full list of the Executive Board of the Swim Committee is reprinted in this issue, with addresses.

While the Executive Committee is appointed totally at the discretion of the President of the Swim Committee, Peter Plante announced that his selection was made to include chairmen of sub-committees, members of National AAU Committees, and members at large. Peter wants members at large to be made up predominately of smaller teams and wants geographical distribution. There are a limited number of openings for active clubs who request representation on the Committee. For further information concerning this, write directly to Peter Plante.

The Project Committee Chairman, John Larrabee, was informed that the Exeter Pool has been reserved for the NEW ENGLAND ALL STAR SELECTION MEET for March 15 & 16. It was agreed that no awards will be given at this meet, but that proceeds will be used to defray a portion of the expenses for sending the winners to Quebec. In an effort to be consistent, we will again use the age on the day of the Quebec Meet as the Meet age.*

Since the immediately-important rule changes made by National had been published in the November issue of N-P, it was decided to defer any further report on rules changes made by National AAU, since most of these are of the "housecleaning" variety. National AAU has added the 500-Free Short Course, and 400 Free Long Course to the list of 11-12 recognized events.

Joe Thompson & Paul Parenteau are accepting names in advance for Official Timers for the N. E. Age Group Championships at Exeter. (Both names are on the list below). Please sent your name directly to one of these officials if you are willing to serve.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE NEWS

The Executive Board of the Swim Committee met January 20, and again on February 3. NEAAU Swimming Rules revisions were a major portion of the agenda. Work on these revisions continues under Committee Chairman Bob Pyatt.

Joe Thompson announces that Officials Patches are available at \$3.00 each from the official who ran your qualification clinic. Every official should wear his patch when officiating. Patches also available from Joe, WSC.

The New England Senior Championships will be held at BROCKTON HIGH SCHOOL, March 7-9, and follows the normal 3-day format. Those qualified and willing to officiate should immediately contact Dick Lennon, Meet Director, 5 Wiley Road, Woburn. A note to Dick stating which day you can help will be most welcome.

The All-Star Qualifying Meet (for the Quebec-New England All-Star Meet) will be held at Exeter March 15 & 16.

It is expected that the All-Star Meet will be held April 26.

Important: Swimmers must enter the qualifying meet in the age-group they are in as of April 26, not March 15. If you change age-groups between Mar.15 and April 26, please note. A list of events is given on Page 2.

The Board announces that efforts are under way to arrange a summer all-star meet with Connecticut (similar to the Quebec-New England Meet).

LETTER FROM PETER PLANTE, President of NEAAU Executive Committee:

With the growth of swimming in New England, it is becoming apparent that some youngsters are entering "C" Meets without proper preparation. In some cases the swimmer obviously cannot do the stroke at the required distance.

I feel strongly that the team coach is responsible for making certain that any member of his team entering an event can swim the stroke with some proficiency at the required distance. AAU Meets, even of the "C" calibre are for swimmers who have already demonstrated to the coach in practice, their ability to meet AAU swim standards.

Coaches are only doing disservice to a beginning swimmer by anticipating his abilities. It is suggested that the coach precede Meet entries by a time-trial.

First of all, on behalf of the Swim Committee and all those interested in New England swimming, I would like to thank our outgoing chairman, Peter Plante. During the past year Pete has worked hard and long hours doing a sometimes thankless job.

Since the last NEWSLETTER was published, there have been two general meetings of the Swim Committee. The Annual Meeting was held on Saturday, May 10, at the Medford Community High School. Major topics discussed at that meeting were the financial status of the Committee, since a portion of the participation fee from swimmer paid to AAU is no longer returned to the Committee for our operational expenses; the calendar of meets for the summer season; representation at the Quarterly and Annual meetings of the New England Association; the feasibility of having a paid, part-time secretary to handle correspondence and inquiries about New England swimming; the possibility of paying major officials (starter and referee) at swim meets, and the election of officers.

A discussion of the revisions of the By-Laws and Rules, on the agenda for the Annual Meeting, was postponed until a Special Meeting on Wednesday, May 21, again at Medford. Copies of the revisions were available at the Annual Meeting, and the membership was urged to be ready to discuss changes and amendments at the May 21 meeting. The major amendments made and accepted included the following:

1. Membership of the Swim Committee shall consist of one representative from each member AAU Swim Club who have paid their annual NEAAU dues and their annual NEAAU Competitive Swim Committee dues (established at the annual meeting), members of National Swim Committees, and members-at-large. Note: To defray the operational expenses of the Committee (mailing, copying, etc.) and to insure a vote and receiving official reviews, each member club must send to the Committee Secretary a fee of \$5.00 for the year beginning May 1, 1975.

2. The formation of a Budget sub-committee to be chaired by the Treasurer. This sub-committee has, and will continue each year, to formulate a working budget by which the Committee can produce some income and meet its expenses each year.

3. Requests for dates for meets must be in writing to the Chairman of the Calendar sub-committee prior to that committee's semi-annual meetings. Requests for dates during the period of June 1 to December 31 must be made before April 1 of each year. Requests for dates during the period between Nov. 1 and July 15 should be made prior to October 1. (see note on the Summer Calendar of Meets).

4. In order to conform to the current National Swimming Rules, trophies for team and individual high-point winners at B and C meets shall NOT be given.

Copies of the completed By-Laws are now being produced and will be available free to all member clubs upon request, and to individuals for a charge of 50¢ per copy. Individuals please enclose self-addressed stamped envelope with request. Available from Secretary.

Approved at the last meeting was the addition of a surcharge of 5¢ per event, which will be paid to the Competitive Swim Committee, from ALL NeAAU sanctioned meets immediately. The entry fee will remain 75¢ for A meets, and 50¢ for B & C Meets, but entrants will pay 80¢ and 55¢ respectively for individual events. Surcharge does not apply to relays or to swimmers of the host club. The surcharge, which has been implemented in other AAUs is intended to meet swim committee expenses, and assist in all-star team and trip expenses, patches and other things which promote NEAAU swimming.
