SUBJ: Memorial Day Development Camp Information

The latest LSC mailing to all general chairmen includes a packet of the camp information and applications. (An application is also enclosed with this letter.) In addition, each camp director has been sent a supply in case there are direct requests.

For your information, this information booklet is also reproduced in its entirety in the March U.S. Swimming News. Additionally, a copy of the flyer has been sent to every USS registered athlete that falls in the appropriate age group, that of boys born in 1970 and girls born in 1971.

As you will notice, besides general information, the pamphlet contains the actual application to apply for the camp.

Deadline for application is April 2, 1984. This is also the cut-off date to make the qualifying times.

PLEASE NOTE:

In reviewing the flyer I have found two confusing points. While we are not able to correct 25,000 copies, hopefully we can work it out.

1. The application does not have a space for the applicant to indicate which camp he wishes to apply for. He does not have to apply to the camp nearest his home.
2. The "dates to remember" say April 2 is the deadline to get the application to the LSC Verification Official, who will mail the application to the camp director by April 16.

In fact, the application asks the swimmer to submit the form to the nearest camp director.

To alleviate some of this problem, the camp directors who receive the application can return the group to the LSC for verification and then get the apps. back, or you can call.

Each LSC will need to set up a verification official. Please mail that name, address and phone number to me and I will forward it to each camp director. If the times can be verified before being sent to the camp director, all the better.

Following the receipt of completed applications by the camp director, he should make sure the times have been verified. He then selects the 25 fastest boys and 25 fastest girls. The camp director will notify all those accepted and verify that they wish to attend the camp. If someone declines, he can go to the next fastest swimmer.

The camp directors will meet in Colorado Springs April 27-29 to go over the camp program. At that time a full roster will be turned in to USS. At the directors' meeting, if a camp isn't full, a director can check with other directors to see if he has names of those who may not have qualified, to fill in the empty spots.

After the directors' meeting all those swimmers who were not selected will be notified as such.

Camp directors will then contact each swimmer in his camp with a welcoming letter and a notice of the schedule for that particular camp.

Examples of many of these letters will be forwarded to each camp directors.

The camps begin at 6:00 P.M. on Friday, May 25th and conclude at 12:30 P.M. Monday, May 28th.

As a reminder, any coach is welcome to visit any camp during any part of the program to observe. However, he will not be allowed to participate in the program.

Each camp will have at least three coaches, one of which will be a female. A fourth coach will be added for 26 swimmers and a fifth coach for 40 swimmers.

More detailed information with specific program items will be forthcoming in early April. If there are any particular questions, please feel free to call the National Headquarters.

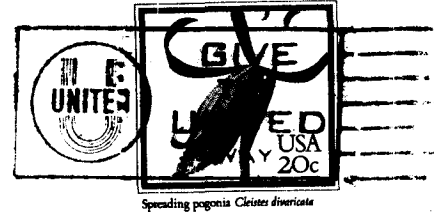

NEW FEE AND SURCHARGE POLICY

SINCE THERE HAS BEEN SOME PROBLEM COLLECTING SURCHARGE AND CLUB FEES THE BOARD PASSED THE FOLLOWING POLICY UNANIMOUSLY ON APRIL 10 AT THE SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING. THIS POLICY IS RETROACTIVE TO APRIL 1, 1984.

1. SURCHARGE FEES ARE DUE 10 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF A MEET --ALONG WITH RESULTS. FEES NOT PAID 30 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF A MEET WILL ACCRUE INTEREST AT THE RATE OF 1 1/2% PER MONTH.
2. IF FEES ARE NOT PAID WITHIN THREE MONTHS THE SWIMMERS OF THE CLUB INVOLVED WILL BE REQUIRED TO SWIM UNATTACHED UNTIL THE MONEY IS PAID.
3. IF FEES ARE NOT PAID WITHIN THREE MONTHS, THE CLUB INVOLVED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RUN ANOTHER MEET FOR 12 MONTHS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF THEIR MEET.

IN ADDITION THE FOLLOWING POLICY WAS PASSED REGARDING SUBSIDY MONEY:

1. REQUESTS FOR SHORT COURSE SUBSIDY MONEY MUST BE MADE BY AUGUST 31 OR THE CLUB/ INDIVIDUAL FORFEITS THEIR RIGHT TO THE SUBSIDY FOR THAT SEASON.
2. REQUESTS FOR LONG COURSE SUBSIDY MONEY MUST BE MADE BY DECEMBER 31 OR THE CLUB/ INDIVIDUAL FORFEITS THEIR RIGHT TO THE SUBSIDY FOR THAT SEASON.

SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING AND BANQUET

THE SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING AND BANQUET USUALLY HELD IN JUNE WILL BE HELD IN THE FALL ONLY THIS YEAR. THE TOP TEN BOOKS WILL BE OUT IN MID-JUNE FOR SHORT COURSE SEASON AND AWARDS WILL BE MADE AT THE FALL BANQUET TO INCLUDE LONG COURSE.

OLYMPIC TAX CHECK-OFF ACT - H.R. 1984 - COMES CLOSER TO CONGRESSIONAL PASSAGE

NGB LOBBYING ACTION DEEMED CRITICAL BY USOC'S MILLER

The Olympic Check Off Act, H.R. 1984, came another step closer to passage in March as the bill was heard before the U.S. House of Representatives subcommittee of the Judiciary Committee. Because of the nature of the bill, it must be heard before both the full Judiciary Committee and the House Ways and Means Committee.

The hearing was the first the USOC has been able to secure in the House in more than two years of efforts, and represents a major breakthrough in the political efforts of the USOC on this bill.

The Olympic Check-Off Act would allow U.S. taxpayers to voluntarily contribute \$1 of their refund, or add an extra \$1 to their tax payment to go to the United States Olympic Committee. The bill, if passed would not cost the U.S. government any money as the USOC would reimburse the United States for the administrative expenses of the Act. F. Don Miller, Executive Director of the USOC, estimates that the passage of the Olympic Check-Off Act would add around \$25 million dollars to the United States Olympic Foundation.

In a meeting with representatives of various National

Governing Bodies at the USOC headquarters in Colorado Springs on March 17, 1984, Miller stated that the passage of this bill was imperative to the future of amateur sports in the United States. He further stated that if the bill did not pass in 1984, its future was doubtful.

"All National Governing Bodies will share in the revenue from this bill," Miller said.

The Tax Check-Off bill is part of the three legged stool of future Olympic financing that includes profits from the Los Angeles Olympic Organizing Committee and proceeds from the Olympic coins currently being marketed by the USOC.

Miller said all NGB's should urge their members to contact their Senators and Congressmen asking them to vote in favor of the H.R. 1984.

"This is probably the most important thing we can accomplish outside of athletic competition in 1984," Miller said, "I urge each of you to let your voice be heard in our nation's capital."

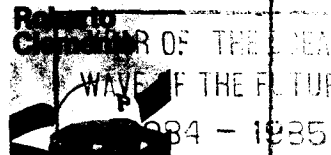

The following items were discussed and voted upon at the Annual Meeting, Coaches Association Meeting or the Board Meeting of November 13, 1984:

CHANGES IN LONG COURSE, 1985, CALENDAR

July 12--14 New England Seniors
July 19--21 Age Group Qualifier
Aug. 2--4 Age Groups

CHANGES IN SHORT COURSE CALENDAR

The December 7--9 meet scheduled for Belmont has been cancelled. In the detailed calendar in this newsletter, please note the change of location for one Age Group Qualifier meet and the change of dates of the Eight and Under Championships and Age Groups.

AGE GROUPS AND SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Swimmers in the 15-18 age groups will not be included in the Age Group meet (March 1-10, 1985) for this season only; cuts for the Senior Championship Meet (March 15-17, 1985) will be the same as the Age Group cuts for 15-18 for this season only. Any swimmer who makes the cut for Seniors (which is now the same as the 15-18 Age Group cut) may swim at Seniors.

EIGHT AND UNDER CHAMPIONSHIPS

For this year only, the cuts for the Short Course Eight and Under Championships (March 2-3) will be the New England Eight and Under "B" cuts (as published in the newsletter for July-August). For next year, the New England eight and under "A" time will be the 25th place at championships, and the New England eight and under "B" time will be the 50th place at championships.

MORE IMPORTANT INFORMATION**"NO DIVING DURING WARM UPS" POLICY:**

At the Annual Meeting the national problem of swimmers diving into crowded warm-up pools was discussed. The problem was deferred to the coaches who formed the following policy which was adopted by the New England Board on November 13, 1984.

1. It is a function of the coaches to educate the swimmers as to the dangers of diving into warm-up pools.

2. The existing rule of unsportsmanlike behavior will apply in this policy.

3. Meet announcements, coaches packets, conspicuous notices at the pools, and announcements during warm-ups will state the policy.

DIVING WILL BE PROHIBITED DURING WARM-UPS IN ANY PART OF THE POOL WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SPRINT LANES WHEN THEY ARE ANNOUNCED.

4. Meet directors will make an effort to block off the starting blocks.

5. At least one official will be on deck during warm ups to enforce this rule.

CONVERSION FACTOR--SHORT COURSE METRES TO SHORT COURSE YARDS

At the Annual Meeting it was voted to use a conversion factor of .9049 to convert short course metre times to short course yard times. These converted times may be used to enter any New England sanctioned meet, including Age Groups and Senior Championships, but may not be used for Top Ten Times. The Portsmouth Aquatic Club "A" meet to be held on February 8-10 will be held in a 25-metre pool, and this conversion factor may be used with the times earned at that meet.

FREE RIBBONS

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The Zone Meet will be held from April 11--13, 1985 in Philadelphia. Trials will be run in two pools, Univ. of Penn., and LaSalle. The finals will take place at LaSalle. This means our team would leave New England on Wednesday, April 10, and return on Sunday, April 14, 1985.

A maximum of 80 swimmers are allowed to compete.

All swimmers must have competed in three N.E. Meets over the course of the 1984-85 season. Age Groups and Seniors can be included in the three. Regions is not included.

Age Group Championships--will be used as the qualifying meet for 14 and unders. Senior Championships will be used for the 15-18's.

The top two in each event will be asked--this does not necessarily mean that the third person in an event goes if one swimmer qualifies for too many events. Each swimmer is allowed to swim six events--no more than three in one day. The meet will be put together to have a well balanced team. The relays are put together on performance at the meet. AGE GROUP QUALIFYING MEETS, February 15--17, 1985

This year there will be two Age Group Qualifying meets, both offering the same events, and both being held the weekend of February 15--17, 1985. New England has been divided up in the following manner:

CAPE ANN Y: All of Vermont, New Hampshire, and Maine (NSC); in Massachusetts--the Gardner area; Winchendon area across to the shore areas; any clubs in Boston proper; all clubs north of Boston; Bernal's Swim Club.

ATTLEBORO: All of Rhode Island; any clubs south of Boston; all of western Massachusetts; Weston Swim Club; Shawmut Aquatic Club; Worcester Swim Club; any clubs south of Worcester, including all of the Worcester area.

New England Swimming reserves the right to transfer a team from one meet to the other if the meets are unevenly subscribed or over subscribed.

MCDONALD'S RIBBONS

First through third place ribbons for all "B" and "C" meets will be provided free for all people who want them for their meets. These are not custom printed with the team name on them, but they are attractive ribbons. If you would like these ribbons, you must ask in writing to the following address: Isabelle Fraser, 125 Franklin Road, Longmeadow, MA 01106. State the number of events you are running in your meet and the number of ribbons you want for you "B" meet or "C" meet. These ribbons should be available after January 1, 1985.

If you are hosting an "A-B" meet, you may have free ribbons for first through third place for the "B" portion of your meet. The only obligation for the free ribbons is to include the following statement: "Ribbons provided by McDonald's Corporation the national sponsor of USS Age Group Swimming." This should be on the front of your program.
